Ang Panalangin ng Ating Dakilang Pinaka-punong Pari

JOHN 17:1-26

Ang mga talatang ating aaralin ay nagbibigay sa atin ng isang bihirang pagsilip sa isang paguusap ng banal na Anak at ng ating Ama na nasa langit. Ito ang tunay na Lord's prayer.

Para sa panahon natin ngayon, ang dalangin na ito ay nagbibigay sa atin ng mga mahalagang katotohanan tungkol sa katiyakan ng ating kaligtasan, sa katapangan natin sa pamumuhay Kristiano, at sa kaaliwan natin sa tibay ng ating kaugnayan sa ating Dios Ama.

1. Ang Ating Katiyakan (v. 1-5)

Isang dalangin para sa kalualhatian ng Dios sa pamamagitan ng kaligtasan ng kanyang mga hinirang, na maging kaloob niya sa mahal niyang Anak.

- Ang layunin ng kaligtasan natin ay ang kalualhatian ng Dios Ama sa pamamagitan ng kalualhatian ng Dios Anak...
- Ang sanhi ng kalualhatian ay ang pagbibigay ng buhay na walang hanggan sa lahat ng pinagkaloob ng Ama sa Anak, batay sa autoridad na kanyang tinanggap mula sa Ama.
- Ang pinagmulan ng kalualhatian ng Anak ay ang kanyang pagsunod sa Ama, at ang pagiging masunurin na iyan, ay dapat ding makita sa lahat nang iniligtas niya.

2. Ang Ating Katapangan (v. 6-19)

Isang panalangin para sa kalualhatian ng Dios sa pamamagitan ng pagbabanal ng kanyang mga alagad, na mananatili sa sanlibutan kahit na sila ay hindi taga sanlibutan.

- Ito ay para sa mga tumanggap at nanampalataya sa rebelasyon ng Ama ng kanyang Salita, na si Kristo Hesus (John 1:1 — “Sa simula ay ang Salita, at ang Salita ay kasama ng Diyos, at ang Salita ay Diyos.”)

- b. Idinalangin niya na ang kanyang mga alagad ay magkaisa at mapanatili sa kanilang kaugnayan sa Dios.
- c. Idinalangin din niya na magkaroon ng kagalakan ang lahat na kanyang tagasunod.
- d. Idinalangin pa niya na ilayo sila ng Ama sa tukso ng Diablo, sapagkat sila ay kamumuhian ng sanlibutan sapagkat sila at hindi taga sanlibutan.
- e. Idinalangin pa niya na sila ay pakabanalin ng Ama para sa banal na paglilingkod sa kanya sa pamamagitan ng kanyang Salita.

3. Ang Ating Kaaliwan (v. 20-26)

Isang panalangin para sa pagbubukod ng Iglesya sa isang banal na ugnayan sa ating Tatluhang Dios.

- a. Ipinalangin niya yaong mananampalataya sa kanya (makataong perspektibo ng kaligtasan) sa pamamagitan ng ministeryo na kanyang mga apostol (ang lahat ng mga Kristiano sa kabuoan ng kasaysayan)
- b. Idinalangin din niya na ang lahat ng tunay na mananampalataya ay magkaisa katulad ng pagkakaisa ng Ama at Anak
- c. Idinalangin pa niya na ang lahat ng mananampalataya ay makasama ni Kristo at makita ang kanyang kalualhatian, na naka angkla sa pag-ibig ng Ama para sa Anak, at sa lahat na kanyang pinagkaloob sa kanya na maligtas.

Discussion Questions

1. Gaano kadalas ninyo ipanalangin ang inyong mga kamag-anak o kaibigan na hindi pa Kristiano; para sila ay tumanggap na kay Hesus? Hindi madalas? O hindi kailanman?! Humingi ng tawad sa Dios kung kayo'y nagkulang sa panalangin. Ipanalangin sila ngayon at gamitin ang mga sangkap ng dalangin ng ating Panginoon sa inyong panalangin.
2. Mayroon bang panahon na kayo'y nag-aalinlangan kung kayo mismo ay ligtas na kay Hesus? Anong bahagi ng dalangin na ito ang nagbibigay sa inyo ng katiyakan na kayo nga ay ligtas nang tunay at hinding-hindi na mawawalay sa ating Ama?

How is Listening to God integral to Missions?

Last year, we learned that God's people, the Church, must embrace being the "Future Church: Mobilizing GCF to Impact the World Today and Tomorrow." We also learned in 2019, the call to be "Creative Witnesses as a Scattered Church". The church is responding actively to God's call through our Kingdom Impact initiatives: 1) Empowering GCFers for missional ministries, 2) Enlisting mission partners, 3) Establishing church plants, 4) Embracing Biblical social engagements, 5) Entering the digital space as a mission field.

This is why for 2021, we now call on the church to fuel its passion for the Great Commission and the Great Commandment by focusing on one of our church's core values of "vibrant worship and prayer (Acts 2:42-47)." We must understand the vital role of prayer in God's mission. We must actively listen and trust our God who hears and speaks to his people (Psalm 3:4; Psalm 17:6; 2 Chronicles 7:14; Isaiah 65:24).

The urgency to bring the Gospel to the nations has never been more clear, and so we call on the church to PRAY to the God of Mission as we continue on with our commitment to "make disciples of Christ in the Philippines and beyond".

So what is in store for Missions Month?

- 1. Preaching of the Word:** Hear God's Word on-site and online through our Sunday Worship services. Other avenues to hear and study God's Word together are: the RGCF Devotionals on Monday and Friday, Midweek Prayer Services, as well as KidsLIFE Sunday School and YouthLIVE services.

This will guide us on how to pray for our missions partners and missionaries.
- 3. ChisMissions:** On all Saturdays of July, learn from various missionaries, as we chat with them concerning key issues in missions today, in partnership and co-hosted by the Disciple-Making Groups of GCF. This will be via Zoom, so save the link bit.ly/GCFChisMissions.
- 4. Growth Groups:** Discuss and apply God's Word through our Missions Month Weekly Study Guide as we collectively listen, pray and obey God's Word in the building up of His Kingdom.

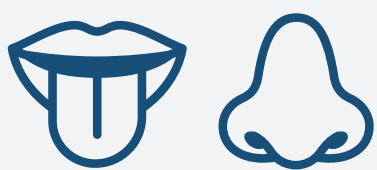
