#### **SOUTH KOREA**

- Pray for South Korea, for their protection in such proximity to
  the threats of North Korea. Pray for the reunification of Korea

   a deep desire of the Korean people. Ask God for wisdom
  upon their leaders, for them to reaffirm the 1991 inter-Korean
  agreement on reconciliation, non-aggression, exchanges, and
  cooperation as a transformational expression for peace and
  reunification.
- Pray for a continued blessing on the South Korean churches and its remarkable commitment to fervent prayer, for perseverance as a missions-sending nation, flexibility, and cultural sensitivity to be effective abroad. Finally, ask God to compel the youth to have genuine Christian faith rather than the expectations and offerings of the world.
- Starting July, those vaccinated with at least one Covid-19 shot will no longer be required to wear masks outdoors and will be allowed to gather in large numbers. Pray for the Covid-19 vaccine rollout to be successful as the government aims to immunize 70% of its 52 million people by September.
- Pray that the rusty trains, halted in the Demilitarized Zone after the Armistice Agreement for 68 years, may run again on the track carrying peace and prosperity with them to Northeast Asia and the world.

#### **NORTH KOREA**

- Pray for the volatile situation of the threat of nuclear power in North Korea. Pray that all strategies and aspects of the threat to use their army and armaments against other nations be exposed and stopped.
- Pray for the citizens of North Korea who live in poverty and malnutrition, for the truth to set them free from years of terror, deception, indoctrination, and isolation. Pray for God to deliver a nation long-enslaved by a brutal regime.
- Pray for the unknown number of Christians who are in the most oppressive place in the world. Ask God for hope, protection, comfort, encouragement, and for the church to persevere and multiply amid horrific persecution. Remember the believers in prisons and labor camps; pray for their families who need food supplies and medicines.
- Pray for President Kim Jong-Un that God would open his eyes to the gospel of Jesus Christ, wise counsel, diplomacy and negotiation, and the suffering of the people of his nation. Ask God to set him free of every spiritual bondage and deception.
