1 SAMUEL 3:1-11

- 1. Maririnig natin ang Salita ng Diyos sa tuwing tayo ay Kanyang tawagin. (vv. 2-5)**

  - Gumagawa ang Diyos ng paraan upang tayo ay makausap.

  - Ginagamit ng Diyos ang ibang tao upang tayo ay Kanyang makausap.
  - Handa dapat ang ating puso at isipan sa mga pangaral sa atin ng Diyos.
- 3. Tinawag tayo ng Panginoon upang ihayag ang Kanyang kaluwalhatian. (v. 11)**
  - Tayo ay inutusan para sa ating kapakanan at para sa Kanyang kabanalan.
