Lesson Aims

- To learn how to listen to God's voice when He speaks through His word.
- 2. To prayerfully learn how to discern His voice when He calls.
- 3. To understand the difference between hearing and listening to His voice.
- 4. To faithfully answer His call and live lives that will bring glory to His name.
- 5. To respond to His voice faithfully.

Discussion Questions

- 1. How did Samuel respond to the voice/call of God at first?
- 2. When did God call Samuel? What was happening during that time?
- 3. What do you think was Eli's role to Samuel in terms of prayer?
- 4. Why did Samuel not recognize God's voice? How would you respond if you were Samuel?

- 5. How do you think Samuel felt when he realized that it was God who was calling him?
- 6. When did Samuel hear God's voice? When did he listen? What do you think is the difference between the two?
- 7. What did God tell Samuel?
- 8. How did Eli respond to the vision of God through Samuel? Why do you think Eli reacted that way?
- 9. How can you resonate with the communication between God and Samuel?
- 10. Who do you relate with the most in this story? (Eli, Samuel, possible servants, family members, etc.) What does that say about you?

Walk

- 1. When was the last time you heard God's voice? Are there things in your life that are preventing your fellowship with God from deepening? What do you think your next steps should be?
- 2. What is the difference between Samuel's communication with God and ours?
- 3. Christians must value the power of prayer. How much do we value it as individuals, community, and church?
- 4. What do you think will happen when we ignore God's voice?
- 5. What do you think is the connection of this passage to the Great Commission?
- 6. How will you challenge yourself to obey God's voice and the Great Commission proactively? How do you see yourself participating in the Great Commission during the pandemic?
- Samuel presented himself before God when He called him. God called, and he listened and obeyed. We must discern God's voice from the other voices that might influence us in our everyday lives.
