

Kayamanang Selyado at Sigurado sa Langit

EPHESIANS 1:13-14

Kay Kristo mayroon tayong mga dakilang pagpapala at kayamanan mula sa Dios — pagpili sa atin para sa kaligtasan mula sa Ama, pagtubos sa atin mula sa kasalanan mula sa Anak, at pag-sigurado ng ating mana sa langit mula sa Espiritu Santo. Ang lahat ng ito ay para sa kapurihan ng kanyang malualhating kagandahang-loob.

Sa ating teksto, makikita natin ang isang katotohanang makapagbibigay ng lakas ng loob sa atin, para harapin ang kasalukuyang paghihirap natin sa buhay na ito — Kay Kristo Hesus, mayroon tayong kayamanan na selyado na, at sigurado pa, na naghihintay sa atin sa langit!

1. Kayamanang Selyado sa Langit (Efeso 1:13)

- a. Nakasama sa biyayang ito ang mga Hentil na mananampalataya kay Kristo
- b. Nakasandig ang biyayang ito sa pagdinig ng ebanghelyo ng kaligtasan
- c. Nagresulta ang biyayang ito dahil sa nakaliligtas na pananampalataya kay Kristo
- d. Naging selyado ang biyayang ito ng pinangakong Diwang Banal

2. Kayamanang Sigurado sa Langit

- a. Ang Diwang Banal ang garantiya ng ating mana sa langit.
- b. Ang mana na ito ay tiyak na ating makakamtan, dahil ito ay magbibigay papuri sa kanyang kalualhatian.

Napaka-dakila ang mga pagpapala na ating natanggap mula sa ating Panginoon — pagpili sa atin para sa kaligtasan mula sa Dios Ama, pagtubos sa atin mula sa kasalanan mula sa Dios Anak, at pag-sigurado ng ating mana sa langit mula sa Dios Espiritu Santo.
