

- 1. Ang Hangarin ng Kabutihan para sa Kalaban (Jeremiah 29:7) "⁷ Tumulong kayo para sa kabutihan at kaunlaran ng lungsod na pinagdalhan sa inyo. Ipanalangin nyo ito dahil kapag umunlad ito, uunlad din kayo. (ASND)"
- 2. Ang Leksyon Para sa Piniling mga Mamamayan (Jeremiah 29:10) Hindi Tayo Pababayaan ng Diyos (Leviticus. 26:40-45; Hebrews. 12:10-11)
- 3. Ang Diyos Natin ay Mapagkakatiwalaan (Jeremiah 29:11) "¹¹Alam ko kung paano ko tutuparin ang mga plano ko para sa kabutihan n'yo at hindi sa kasamaan n'yo, at plano para bigyan kayo ng pag-asa na magkaroon kayo ng mabuting kinabukasan. (ASND)"






