





Three Precious Truths Every Christian Should Know

Three Precious Truths Every Christian Should Know (Part 1)

EPHESIANS 1:15-23

What would you ask God for someone you really cared about? Paul prayed for three things for his Ephesian friends because he knew what they needed most. And what was good for them should be precious for us. So, whether for yourself or those you deeply care about, it is good to know these truths, these prayer requests, that we can ask from God and can be certain that He will grant if we genuinely desire them.

MAIN PETITION: After expressing his deep joy over his friends, Paul's main prayer was that God would grant spiritual insight to God's people through the Holy Spirit. This would lead them to realize what they already had:

1. WHEN YOU FEEL HOPELESS: In Christ, God has given us a hope that never ends.

• We have an eternal hope that doesn't depend on our goodness but on God's grace. This hope is the absolute certainty of our victory in Christ (Romans 8:23-24).


2. WHEN YOU FEEL WORTHLESS: In Christ, God has blessed us with a glorious future.

 We not only have a glorious inheritance in Christ (all the spiritual blessings in Ephesians 1:3-14), but we are an inheritance to Christ. This is true of all who are in Christ: God views us in His Beloved Son and values us accordingly.

3. WHEN YOU FEEL HELPLESS: In Christ, God has granted us immeasurable power

We have within us the same power that raised Christ from the dead!





FINAL THOUGHTS

Thoughts of hopelessness, worthlessness, and helplessness attack us at various points in our lives. But the Word reminds us that we've already been given all that we need, in Christ. Realizing and letting these precious truths change the way we think, will change the way we live (Romans 12:2).

- 3. Paul encouraged the Ephesians by telling them exactly how he was praying for them. How will you do this with the people you pray for?
- 4. In your group, close in prayer and ask each person in the group to pray at least one of the three prayer requests of Paul for another person in the group.

THE HEART OF WORSHIP

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. I miss worshipping the LORD with you, inside our Ortigas Center sanctuary. I miss the koinonia after each service at the lobby. I miss the laughter, the kids screaming, the atmosphere. I miss the warmth and "kumustahan." I miss seeing you, in the flesh, my GCF family.

These are some of the blessings of worshipping together, physically. But as I often remind myself, the heart of worship is all about our God. Our compassionate, merciful, gracious, loving, and faithful LORD is the beginning and end of worship. It's all about Him! Let's not miss the point. Let's keep the main thing, the main thing. We come to worship with hearts and souls bowed. We come to worship as offerors. We come to worship, to give to God the glory due His name.

We live in a consumption-driven world. The artificial intelligence and the algorithms in our digital world makes sure we consume more of what we search for on the internet. It is habit forming. As a result of this experience, the danger is that we bring this consumer mindset into a time of worship. It becomes "me-centered" instead of "God-centered." "Bless me with your singing. Bless me with the message." We become critical. It is important that we are aware of this danger. Let us avoid this pitfall. What should we need to do?

Prepare. Give.

Prepare our hearts and souls, to worship and bow down; to kneel before the LORD, our Maker. (Psalm 95:6) Prepare to bring an offering. Prepare by bringing to mind who He is and what He has done. Give and offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that acknowledge His name. (Hebrews 13:15-16) Give thanks to the Lord; bless His name. (Psalm 100:4)

Prepare what you have purposed in your heart to give, not out of compulsion, but with a cheerful heart. (2 Corinthians 9:7) Give your gift, your fragrant offering, your sacrifice acceptable and pleasing to God. (Philippians 4:18)

Prepare by quieting your hearts before Him. Cease the other activities. Draw near to listen. (Ecclesiastes 5:1) You are in the presence of God.

Finally, give your life, as a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable and pleasing to God, which is your spiritual act of worship. (Romans 12:1)

WORSHIP THROUGH GIVING
