




# Three Precious Truths Every Christian Should Know (Part 2)

**EPHESIANS 1:15-23** 

How differently will you think or live today if you believed with all your heart that God would never fail you? That He has given you everything you need to live a life that pleases God?

In this second part of a message based on Paul's prayer for people he loved, we look at Paul's desire for them to realize that "In Christ, God has granted us immeasurable Power." So, what are the implications of the limitless power and authority of Jesus Christ over all things in heaven and earth?

# 1. CHRIST'S MATCHLESS POWER (Ephesians 1:19-20) — God's power means He cannot and will not ever fail you

- The **Essence** of Jesus' Infinite Power: Paul struggled for words and combined four Greek synonyms ("power", "working", 'great" and "might") yet barely captured the magnitude of the might of Jesus.
- The **Effect** of Jesus' Infinite Power: We often underestimate Christ's power by simple ignorance. God's power didn't just raise Jesus from the dead; it raised Him all the way back to His throne in heaven where He sits in the seat of power.

God's power doesn't spare us from difficulty, danger, or death; but makes us more than conquerors in these situations (Romans 8:31-39). This is the power to live in an evil world. This is the power to have a God-pleasing life; to find genuine joy today as a foretaste of heaven forever. So, rather than ask God for power, we need faith to believe in His power within, and the faithfulness to use it. God cannot and will not ever fail you.



# 2. CHRIST'S MAJESTIC POSITION (Ephesians 1:21-23) — God's power means He cannot and will not ever fail His Church

- The **Scope** of Jesus' Authority: Christ's power puts Him above all angelic ranks, above all personalities, across all of history.
- The **Significance** of Jesus' Authority: Christ is Lord over all creation and Head of the Church, which He fills with all blessings.

This is what Jesus meant when He said "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me" (Matthew 28:18). All the power that the church needs to fulfill its mission is in Christ. All the power that the church needs to thrive in the worst conditions is all in Christ. God cannot and will not ever fail His Church.

#### **FINAL THOUGHTS**

May I ask you again: How differently will you think or live today, if you really believed with all your heart that God would never fail you? God will only allow what is good in His sight (Romans 8:28) to happen to you, whether it's obviously good, possibly good, or seemingly bad. It's the same with His church. Whether for you as an individual or for a local congregation that stays faithful to His will, God cannot and will not ever fail. God is too powerful to fail!

#### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. What practical difference would it make if we fully comprehend the power of God within us as believers?
- 2. What does Ephesians 1:15-23 say about the exaltation of Jesus? How might living with this awareness change a believer's life in a positive way?
- 3. What does "good" really mean in Romans 8:28? Why is it dangerous to force our own definition of what is "good" on this famous verse?
- 4. As you close in prayer, if you know of any fellow believer who needs a deeper sense of God's power at work in and through them, use this opportunity to lift them up to the Lord.
