Uhen God Became Flesh

MATTHEW 1:18-23

TODAY'S MESSAGE | DECEMBER 12, 2021

We take time off from our Ephesians Book Study, this December, to focus on the meaning of Christ's incarnation for our church family – what the world celebrates as "Christmas."

In order for us to fully appreciate the implications of God breaking into our world, let us look at a familiar and well-loved story from another angle:

1. The Miraculous Conception of Jesus

"...before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit." (Matthew 1:18)

"...that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit." (Matthew 1:20)


In the genealogy of Matthew 1:1-17, Joseph is never called "the father of Jesus." He is simply called "the husband of Mary, of whom Jesus was born, who is called Christ" (Matthew 1:16). This emphasizes that Jesus was born from a human mother but not a human father. Galatians 4:4 says, "When the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of woman, born under the law." Again, no human father is mentioned.

 To make atonement for our sins, Jesus had to be fully man To have the authority to forgive sin and conquer death, He had to be fully God. The miraculous conception is how God accomplished all of these through Jesus Christ.

2. The Missional Calling of Jesus

"…you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins." (Matthew 1:21)

- The name "Jesus" (Matthew 1:21), a Greek form of the Hebrew name "Joshua," means "salvation is of God." His Name reveals the redemptive nature of His ministry – to "save His people from their sins."
- God is a missional God. The Father sent the Son (1 John 4:9-10), whose life, death, and resurrection is our message (1 Corinthians 15:1-5). The Father and the Son sent the Holy Spirit (John 14:16, 26; John 15:26). The Son sent us, the church, empowered by the Spirit, to the nations (Matthew 28:18–20; Acts 1:8; John 20:21).

3. The Majestic Character of Jesus

"...and they shall call His name Immanuel." (which means, God with us) (Matthew 1:23)


- "Immanuel" reveals who the Lord Jesus is, His fully divine and majestic nature. "God with us" means He is here to lead and guide us, but also to rule and judge the earth in His appointed time.
- In Jesus, nobody less than God came right where we are. And at the end of Matthew's Gospel, there is the promise that Jesus will be with us to the end of the age (Matthew 28:20) – God with us indeed!

FINAL THOUGHTS

Christmas reveals these important truths about Jesus – His Conception, Calling, and Character. Christmas isn't just a fun event (it is). Nor is it just a most awaited annual distraction (it can be). It is also a deeply theological and profoundly doctrinal event that every Christian should know. Right behavior is founded on right doctrine. We do what we believe, so we must believe rightly. May this lead us all to glad worship and joyful service!

Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." (Isaiah 9:6)




