THE SHEPHERD'S VOICE

Pastor BJ Sebastian Disciple-Making Ministry

LUKE 2:8-20 SAYS:

"8 And in the same region there were shepherds out in the field... ¹⁰ And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. 11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. 12 And this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths and lying in a manger." 13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying, 14 "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom he is pleased!"...¹6 And they went with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby lying in a manger. ¹⁷ And when they saw it, they made known the saying that had been told them concerning this child....²⁰ And the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen, as it had been told them."

In this very familiar account of the first Christmas eve, we see the angels announcing the fulfillment of the Lord's promise to send the offspring of Abraham, and the son of David, into the world. They announced the birth of a Savior, who is Christ the Lord! But this Christ would be identified as a "a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths;" and "lying in a manger." The Messiah of God born as a helpless babe, and in the humblest of circumstances. This is the incarnation of the eternal God. This is Christmas.

Still the shepherds understood that simple announcement of the glory of God coming down to bring peace to those who are pleasing and precious to Him. So they confirmed the birth and spread the good news to everyone they could share it with -- something that we should be doing today -- especially during this Christmas season when we gather with friends and family to exchange gifts and express our love. Let us follow the shepherds' example. There is no greater gift we can share, and no greater love we can express, than the good news of the coming of Savior to save His people from their sin. This is commanded of us by our Lord. This is expected of us by our God. Let us do it, both for the benefit of our loved ones, and the glory of His Name!
