God's Way to Heaven

• THE GOSPEL

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures," (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)

• THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD
God is holy and righteous:

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty, the whole earth is full of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3). He requires holiness of us as well: "Be holy, for I am holy" (1 Peter 1:16).

THE TRUTH ABOUT CHRIST

Christ is the expression of God's love for us: "God demonstrates his own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8). Christ paid the penalty of our sins and died for sinners: "For Christ died for sins once for all, righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God (1 Peter 3:18).

Through Christ, God offers man reconciliation: "God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them (2 Corinthians 5:18).

WHAT SHOULD WE DO? Believe and receive Jesus as Lord and Savior:

If you confess. With your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

PRAYER:

Lord Jesus, be merciful to me, a sinner. I believe that You are the Son of God who took the penalty for my sins on the Cross. I humbly ask You to be my Savior and submit to you as my LORD forever. Amen.

The Evidence of a Resurrected Life (Internally): Inner Purity

EPHESIANS 4:17-24

A. Consider the Power of the Resurrection:

- Of First Importance 1 Corinthians 15:1-4 (The recap of the finished work of Jesus)
- 2. The Evidence of the Resurrection 1 Corinthians 15:5-9
- 3. The Evidence of the Changed Life 1 Corinthians 15:10-11
- 4. The Evidence of the Living Lord 1 Corinthians 15:20-23
- 5. The Evidence of the Spirit of Life Romans 8:9-11

Now that we are reminded of the Power of the Resurrection of Jesus, let us go to Ephesians and...

B. Consider the Position of the Reprobate: Impurity

- 1. The Personality of the Old Self. (Ephesians 4:17-19)
 - a. "Now this I say and testify in the Lord..." ("therefore" in the King James version)
 - b. No longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk.
 - The futility of their mind
 - Darkened in their understanding
 - Alienated from the life of God
 - Ignorance in them
 - c. Hardness of heart:
 - Callous
 - Sexual deviants
 - Greedy
 - Impure

C. Consider the Proposition for the Redeemed: Inner Purity.

- 1. Putting on the New Self. (Ephesians 4:20-24)
 - a. Put off... the old self... Put on the new self:
 - The idea is to "change into" a different kind of Behavior.
 - b. But that is not the way you learned Christ!
 - The idea of learning and education.
 - See verse 21 Assuming you have Heard and Taught.
 - See verse 23 Renewed in the Spirit of Your Mind.
 - c. The likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness:
 - The new man is the new creation. (2 Corinthians 5:17)

A LIFE WITH INNER PURITY AND HOLINESS!

CONCLUSION

The evidence of a resurrected life: inner purity by the power of the same Spirit of God who raised Jesus from the dead!

- 1. What a contrast there would be if all those in the church truly carried out the admonition to "Walk with the evidence of the resurrected life in purity!"
- 2. The church would stand out like "a city that is set on a hill" as Jesus referred to in Matthew 5:14-16.
- 3. And the world, though it now has "their understanding darkened," might be more likely to come to see the truth that is in Jesus.
- 4. But what hope is there if the church is more like the world than the "holy temple" it is to be?
- 5. Friends, are we not experiencing "The Resurrection Power of the Holy Spirit of God"?

CHALLENGE

Maybe you have not put off the old self? Come to the Resurrected Christ. Believe in Him whom the Father raised to life to glorify Him and save us. Believe in Jesus and experience the inner purity He bought for you on the cross. Will you?
