Guidelines to Living Out the Resurrected Life

EPHESIANS 5:1-6

What does a resurrected life look like? After describing inner purity as internal evidence of new life (Ephesians 4:17-24), and redemptive relationships as external evidence of the same (Ephesians 4:25-32), Paul now gives two guidelines for resurrected lives as practical implications of these truths:

1. LOVE PEOPLE LIKE GOD LOVES YOU (Ephesians 5:1-2)

- a. Love like the Father (Ephesians 4:32: 5:1)
 - Be like the One who loved you and raised you up from the dead, and now raises you spiritually: Ephesians 4:32 "Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you."

b. Love like the Son (Ephesians 5:2)

- Jesus, the Source of our <u>Power</u> to love: We are called to live out an empowered love as a consequence of redemption. God doesn't ask from us what we cannot do!
- Jesus the Son is our <u>Pattern</u> of love: From the teachings and example of Christ, we are enabled to become what He was to God – a gift of love who was pleasing to God.

2. CHOOSE GOD OVER GREED: These things must not even be mentioned among us (Ephesians 5:3-6)

- a. Beware the Greed of Lust (Ephesians 4:19): Revealing itself as sexual immorality, filthiness, foolish talk, or crude joking. Instead, replace your words with thanksgiving.
- b. Beware the Greed of Materialism: Covetousness is a form of idolatry (Colossians 3:5; Exodus 20:7). That coveting is ranked equally evil to sexual immorality reveals how God views all sin as ultimately stemming from the idea of "never enough."
- c. Beware the Outcome of Greed (Ephesians 5:5-6): Everyone enslaved by lust or money has no place in the Kingdom of God. Only the wrath of God awaits such. But you can flee from the wrath to come as you turn to Christ. We are saved by God, from God, through God.

FINAL THOUGHTS

God is against greed because it is the very opposite of love; the love He has given us and which He now wants us to give to others. Love gives, while greed gets. Love says, "Here is more for you," while greed says, "It's never enough for me." May God enable you to live out your resurrected life with His love, through His strength!

1. MAHALIN ANG KAPWA (Ephesians 5:1-2).

- a. Tularan ang Ating Ama.
- b. Tularan ang Pag-ibig ng Ating Panginoong Hesus.

2. IWAKSI ANG KASAMAAN (Ephesians 5:3-6).

- a. Tigilan ang Kasamaan (Ephesians 5:3-4).
- b. Tiyakin ang Pamana sa Kaharian ng Diyos (Ephesians 5:5-6).

PAGWAWAKAS

Malinaw muli ang panawagan ni Pablo. Dahil pinatawad na tayo ng ating Ama kay Kristo Hesus (Ephesians 4:32), kailangan tayong mamuhay sa pag-ibig, katulad ng ating Amang Banal at ang Kanyang Anak na si Kristo Hesus, na Siyang dakilang halimbawa sa atin ng mapag-sakripisyong pag-ibig sa kapwa (1 John 3:16).

Sa ating pamumuhay nang may pag-ibig ng Ama at Anak, kailangan nating tigilan ang kasamaan kung nais nating tiyakin ang ating walang hanggang pamana sa kaharian ng ating Panginoon. ■

If you confess. With your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

PRAYER

Lord Jesus, be merciful to me, a sinner. I believe that You are the Son of God who took the penalty for my sins on the Cross. I humbly ask You to be my Savior and submit to you as my LORD forever. Amen.
