How Should We Walk in This World?

EPHESIANS 5:7-17

After encouraging us to love like Christ and to live like Christ (Ephesians 5:1-6), the Bible gives us further guidance about what this looks like when it comes to living in the real world, the reality where most of those we meet have no personal relationship with Christ:

1. WE ARE TO BLESS THE WORLD WITH OUR LIGHT (Ephesians 5:7-14)

- We are the light of the world, according to Jesus (Matthew 5:14). That's why we cannot share the world's enslavement with lust or money – “the unfruitful works of darkness.” Beware of those who are more likely to influence you for evil than you are to influence them for good.
- Positively, we are to bless the world by contributing “all that is good and right and true.” This is why we must “discern what is pleasing to the Lord” (Romans 12:2).
- Negatively, we are to refuse participation and conversation about the works of darkness and expose them instead (Proverbs 13:18).

2. WE ARE TO WALK IN THE WORLD WITH GOD'S WISDOM (Ephesians 5:15-17)

- Let us make the best use of our time because we are living in the last days (Hebrews 1:2). Current events show the birth pains of a world facing judgment. We are warriors fighting inside enemy territory, not tourists taking a walk in the park (Ephesians 6:11-12). Of all people, we have the most reason to face each day with urgency and excitement!
- Wisdom is to understand and follow the will of the Lord. How do we acquire wisdom? The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is insight (Proverbs 9:10).

FINAL THOUGHTS

We can only bless the world when it sees our light. Therefore, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven (Matthew 5:16). Seek God's will so that you can prioritize your attention, energy, and resources for what pleases God. That's the best use of your time. ■



Lumakad Sa Liwanag at Karunungan

EPHESIANS 5:7-17

PANIMULA

Makikita natin ang panawagan ni apostol Pablo sa mga tunay na mananampalataya kay Hesus na lumakad sa liwanag at karunungan (Ephesians 5:7-17; Matthew 5:14-16; 1 John 1:5-7). Ito ay kailangan upang tayo na mga mananampalataya ni Kristo Hesus ay maging halimbawa sa iba ng kabanalan at karunungan ng Diyos, sa ating paglakad nang hiwalay sa kamunduhan ng sanlibutan.

1. LUMAKAD BILANG MGA ANAK NG LIWANAG (Ephesians 5:7-10)

Bilang mga anak ng banal na Diyos na nabubuhay sa walang-hanggang liwanag, kailangan nating mamuhay nang kakaiba sa kadiliman ng sanlibutan; laging ayon sa kalooban at kagustuhan ng ating Amang nasa langit.

2. LIWANAGAN ANG MGA GAWA NG KADILIMAN (Ephesians 5:11-14a)

Sa ating paglakad nang hiwalay at kakaiba sa sanlibutan, hindi natin maiiwasan na mailantad ang mga gawa ng kadiliman, at dahil dito, ang ating mga buhay ay magsisilbing kahaluturan sa mga makasalanan at hamon na sila ay lumapit na rin sa ating Panginoon.

3. LUMAPIT SA LIWANAG NI KRISTO HESUS (Ephesians 5:14b)

Sa ganitong pamumuhay, ang hamon ni Pablo ay maging mga buhay na panawagan tayo na gumising na ang mga natutulog sa kasalanan at lumapit na sila kay Kristo Hesus upang maligtas.

4. LUMAKAD SA KARUNUNGAN NG PANGINOON (Ephesians 5:15-17)

Ang pamumuhay ng nasa liwanag ay mahirap kung hindi tayo aasa sa karunungan na nagmumula sa ating Panginoon, at itong karunungan na ito ay makakamit lamang natin kung tayo ay laging susunod at magpapasakop sa kalooban ng Diyos.

PAGWAWAKAS

Lumakad tayo sa kaliwanagan at karunungan ng ating Diyos Amang nasa langit; laging ninanais ang Kanyang kaluguran sa ating pang araw-araw na pamumuhay, na laging naka-ayon sa Kanyang dakila at dalisay na kalooban. ■

● THE GOSPEL

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures," (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)

● THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD

● WHAT SHOULD WE DO?

Believe and receive Jesus as Lord and Savior:

If you confess. With your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

● PRAYER

Lord Jesus, be merciful to me, a sinner. I believe that You are the Son of God who took the penalty for my sins on the Cross. I humbly ask You to be my Savior and submit to you as my LORD forever. Amen.
