EPHESIANS SERIES - BUILT ON BIBLICAL BEDROCK: THE CHURCH THAT PLEASES GOD | JUNE 4-5. 2022

What's Love Got to Do With It?

HEBREWS 13:1-6

After the appeal to worship God in Hebrews 12:28, our passage now shows us how. Worship is inseparable from loving others. 1 John 4:20 instructs us, "If anyone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen." We worship God as we love others with His love.

WHO SHOULD WE LOVE? (Hebrews 13:1-4)

1. We show love for God as we love fellow believers. (Hebrews 13:1)

- Loving each other within His family matters most to God, as Jesus said in John 13:34-35: "Just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."
- Paul affirms this in Galatians 6:10, "So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith."

2. We show love for God as we welcome strangers (Hebrews 13:2)

 The point is not that we might mistreat an angel, but God reminds us of past grace we have also received from Him or others (Leviticus 19:34).

3. We show love for God as we minister to the imprisoned and mistreated (Hebrews 13:3)

Matthew 25:36 "I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I
was in prison and you came to me."

4. We show love for God as we are faithful to our spouses (Hebrews 13:4)

 Marriage is sacred to God, and He will judge the immoral and adulterous (Matthew 19:4-6).

WHAT SHOULD WE NOT LOVE? (Hebrews 13:5-6)

- We must not love money. There's a way of gathering it wisely without falling in love with it (Proverbs 6.6-11). Money is a good servant but a heartless master, and to love it is to be ruled by it (1 Timothy 6:10).
- · We are to be content with what we have because:
 - a. God has promised never to forsake us (Hebrews 13:5).
 - b. God has promised to always be our helper (Hebrews 13:6).

FINAL THOUGHTS

What's love got to do with it? Everything. God so loved the world that He gave us His Son, and our response to the love we received through Christ is to worship God joyfully (Hebrews 12:22, 24). We worship God as we love others with His love. ■

PAGWAWAKAS

Ang pag-ibig natin sa ating kapwa ang pinaka-natural na resulta ng pag-ibig ng Diyos sa Kanyang mga hinirang, sapagkat ibinuhos Niya ang Kanyang pag-ibig mismo sa ating mga puso sa pamamagitan ng Espiritu Santo (Romans 5:5). THE GOSPEL

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures," (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)

• THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD

God is holy and righteous: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty, the whole earth is full of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3). He requires holiness of us as well: "Be holy, for I am holy" (1 Peter 1:16).

THE TRUTH ABOUT CHRIST Christ is the expression

of God's love for us: "God demonstrates his own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8). Christ paid the penalty of our sins and died for sinners: "For Christ died for sins once for all, righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God (1 Peter 3:18).

Through Christ, God offers man reconciliation: "God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them (2 Corinthians 5:18).

WHAT SHOULD WE DO? Believe and receive lesus

Believe and receive Jesus as Lord and Savior:

If you confess. With your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

PRAYER

Lord Jesus, be merciful to me, a sinner. I believe that You are the Son of God who took the penalty for my sins on the Cross. I humbly ask You to be my Savior and submit to you as my LORD forever. Amen.

WHY COMMUNION?

Jesus commanded His followers to commemorate His death regularly (1 Corinthians 11:24-29) to always remind themselves of the cost of their salvation through His sacrifice (Hebrews 9:26, 28; 1 Peter 3:18). Communion symbolizes our union with Christ (Romans 6:5) and the unity that believers share with one another (Ephesians 4:5). As 1 Corinthians 10:17 explains, "Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread."

Celebrating the Lord's Table also operates as a purifying influence in the church as believers reflect on the cross and forsake their sin. We examine our hearts, confessing and repenting of any known sin.

We hope and pray you join us in Communion today. All believers are welcome! And if there is anything between you and God, rather than refusing to participate, why not settle it sincerely with God right now (1 John 1:9) and then commemorate with us at the Lord's Table?
