EPHESIANS SERIES - BUILT ON BIBLICAL BEDROCK: THE CHURCH THAT PLEASES GOD | JUNE 11-12, 2022

The Wife Who Pleases God

EPHESIANS 5:21-25, 33

The concept of a Christian wife's biblical submission has become controversial in recent years because of the rise of feminism, including what is called "evangelical feminism." But what does the Bible say about it? This has not been helped by the misuse of some of these verses to justify degrading wives and their role, and even emotionally abusing them. But what does the Bible really say?

1. THE CALL FOR EVERY CHRISTIAN'S SUBMISSION (Ephesians 5:21)

 "Submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ" is both evidence and consequence of being filled with God's Spirit. This submission is described in Philippians 2:3-4:
 "Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others."

2. THE COMMAND FOR THE CHRISTIAN WIFE'S SUBMISSION (Ephesians 5:22)

a. The RECIPIENT of a Christian wife's submission (Ephesians 5:25)

"Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her."
 The husband's headship is not meant to dominate the wife but to guide the home and serve his wife at the cost of his life. This is something the world cannot understand.

b. The <u>REQUIREMENT</u> (and definition) for a Christian wife's submission (Ephesians 5:22, 24, 33)

- "As to the Lord" (Ephesians 5:22)
- "In everything" (Ephesians 5:24)
- "She respects her husband" (Ephesians 5:33)

A Christian wife's submission does not mean:

- · Inferiority as a person
- · Having an inferior role in marriage
- · Never sharing your advice or discussing things in a loving way

A Christian wife's submission is given regardless of:

- Personality
- · Educational/Career Attainment
- Wealth/Income

c. The REASON for a Christian wife's submission (Ephesians 5:23-24)

- The sacrificial headship of Christ (Ephesians 5:23)
- The joyful submission of His church (Ephesians 5:24)

Exceptions to submission (adapted from "Biblical Portraits of Marriage" by Bruce Wilkinson)

- · When it is against the Law of the Lord (unbiblical)
- · When it is against the Laws of the Land (illegal)
- · When it is a Life-threatening situation

FINAL THOUGHTS

There's a way of being a Christian wife without losing your soul—submit to God first as His daughter, then trust and love Him so much that you obey Him, including submitting to a husband whether he deserves it or not. And as we live in a cynical world that says this is politically incorrect and passé, you will discover that the joy of God's daughters in this present life is always best discovered by those who faithfully follow His will. God bless all the Christian wives today!

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures," (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)

• THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD

God is holy and righteous: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty, the whole earth is full of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3). He requires holiness of us as well: "Be holy, for I am holy" (1 Peter 1:16).

THE TRUTH ABOUT CHRIST Christ is the expression

Through Christ, God offers man reconciliation: "God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them (2 Corinthians 5:18).

WHAT SHOULD WE DO? Believe and receive Jesus as Lord and Savior:

If you confess. With your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

Lord Jesus, be merciful to me, a sinner. I believe that You are the Son of God who took the penalty for my sins on the Cross. I humbly ask You to be my Savior and submit to you as my LORD forever. Amen.
