EPHESIANS SERIES - BUILT ON BIBLICAL BEDROCK: THE CHURCH THAT PLEASES GOD | JUNE 25-26, 2022

Becoming Children Who Please God

EPHESIANS 6:1-3

Our passage is the New Testament re-affirmation of one of the Ten Commandments, And it is an established truth that whatever God affirms in the New Testament from the Old Testament demands our attention because it matters much to God!

Note the underlying attitude commanded and how it results in a positive action (behavior) on our part:

1.	THE P A	IN CHILDREN WHO PLEASE GOD
	"Honor vour father and mother"	

a. The Basis for the command: Exodus 20:12, "the first commandment [among the Ten Commandments] with a promise."

Christian children who honor their parents are pleasing to God. That applies whether your parents are still living or not and whether they were good parents or not.

b. The Blessing in the command: "that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land."

When children honor their parents, they'll escape a lot of sin and danger and avoid what could ruin or shorten their lives.

"God enriches the life of the obedient child no matter how long he may live on the earth. Sin always robs us; obedience always enriches us." — Dr. Warren Wiersbe

This promise holds for Christian children today. Seeming exceptions in life don't disprove this any more than Christ's promise to answer prayer (Matthew 7:7) is negated by our faithlessness or unforgiveness.

2.	THE P	_A	OF CHILDREN WHO PLEASE GOD:
	"Obev your parents"		

- a. The ultimate recipient of this obedience is God Himself because we do so as His disciples: "in the Lord." Colossians 3:20 proves that a child's obedience to the parents is pleasing to the Lord.
- b. The underlying reason for obedience—aside from the fact that it should spring from a heart that honors parents—is that a Christian does this as both evidence and consequence of being Spirit-filled (cf. Ephesians 5:18, 21): "for this is right."

FINAL THOUGHTS

Children who honor and obey their parents honor the Lord, our Ultimate Parent. We are all children, so we can all honor our parents and reap blessings doing so. Family members who live in mutual love and submission will have rich, God-given joy that other families can never know. Christians who honor their parents discover the happiness that a loving family brings, imperfect as it is. As we honor and obey our parents (while under their authority), we show that we honor the Lord. In that way, we become children who please God, our Heavenly Father.

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right." (Proverbs 1:8; 6:20; 23:22)

2. Parangalan ang Magulang

"Honor your father and mother." (Exodus 20:12; Deuteronomy 5:16)

3. Asahan ang Pangako ng Diyos

"(this is the first commandment with a promise), "that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land."

THE GOSPEL

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures," (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)

THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD God is holy and righteous:

Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty, the whole earth is full of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3).

He requires holiness of us as well: "Be holy, for I am holy" (1 Peter 1:16).

THE TRUTH ABOUT CHRIST Christ is the expression of God's love for us: "God

or God's love for us: God's demonstrates his own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8). Christ paid the penalty of our sins and died for sinners: "For Christ died for sins once for all, righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God (1 Peter 3:18).

Through Christ, God offers man reconciliation: "God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them (2 Corinthians 5:18).

WHAT SHOULD WE DO? Believe and receive Jesus as Lord and Savior:

If you confess. With your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

PRAYER

Lord Jesus, be merciful to me, a sinner. I believe that You are the Son of God who took the penalty for my sins on the Cross. I humbly ask You to be my Savior and submit to you as my LORD forever. Amen.

CARPE DIEM: An Invitation to GCF Seniors

¹"Come, everyone who thirsts, come to the waters; and he who has no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without price. ² Why do you spend your money for that which is not bread, and your labor for that which does not satisfy? Listen diligently to me, and eat what is good, and delight yourselves in rich food. ⁶ Seek the Lord while he may be found; call upon him while he is near;" (Isa. 55:1-2; 6).

In this passage, Isaiah addressed the exiles who would be called to return to the land and to the Lord. This opportunity would come as an invitation to a rich banquet; something not to be missed. But the people could, if they do not 'seize the day' (Lat. Carpe Diem). Hence the urgent summons.

God invites people to come to Him. By coming they indicate their willingness to trust and obey His Word; and savor His grace. Tragically, people have always tried to find satisfaction in things and not God. Today is no different. Distracted by the restrictive new normal set in place by the persistent pandemic, people tend to gravitate towards lifestyle alternatives that knowingly satisfy the senses, but unknowingly starve the soul. Do not ignore God's gracious, serious invitation: Come, listen, seek, call on Him!

Calling on God is not once-and-done but an ongoing commitment. Such calling means turning to the Lord and departing from the world. This great day will pass and with it our opportunity to choose God. Our earthly day will also pass. And it may happen even before we truly live. Choose God! "Now is the favorable time" (2 Cor. 6:2).
