# Raising Children That Pleases God

Raising children has often been misunderstood and mishandled by fathers today as in the first century Hellenistic society. The neglect and abuse of fathers often causes strained relationships in a Christian household if not irreparable damage to their children.

On the contrary, fathers must play a key role in raising children that pleases God. Our text for today lays down timeless principles a father must know and apply in order to restore and foster relationships between him and his children. A relationship that reflects the divine Father and Son relationship that demonstrates authority and obedience in equality.

### 1. A father must take the lead in training the children

- a. A father's leadership role (headship) never means "authority over" their children but emphasizes Christ's servant role as Savior, provider, and fountainhead of life.
- A father, who executes his God-given authority in a way that retains the individual (and equal) value of his child, is constructive, other-person loving, and has what's best for his child.

### 2. Training must not provoke children to be angry or discouraged

- A father's failure to know and genuinely exercise his God-given authority provokes children to be angry and discouraged.
- To encourage anger is the very opposite of modelling and encouraging a Christ-like life.

### 3. Training that pleases God

- a. "Discipline and instruction of the Lord" clearly indicates raising children with the gospel at the center of their lives.
- b. Fatherhood is living in the likeness of God and seeking to unite the will of our children with our own and with the will of our heavenly Father.

### APPLICATION

- · Nurture children with genuine, good authority.
- Encourage household worship and service.
- · Father with delight.

### **CONCLUSION**

Raising children that pleases God is the primary responsibility of fathers. They are to take the lead in mediating God's fatherly love, character, and authority to their children by creating a Christ-centered culture in the family. They are called to be faithful mediators of God bringing all things in the home under Christ, so that their children might grow up to live a Christ-like life themselves.

### **PANIMULA**

**Mensahe:** Ang Pagpapasakop ng Mga Magulang ay sa Pamamagitan ng Mapagmahal at Maka-Diyos na Pag-aaruga ng Mga Anak

### 1. Ang Hindi Dapat Gawin: Galitin ang mga Anak

- a. Ang May Responsibilidad: Mga Magulang "Fathers..."
- b. Ang Dapat Iwasan: Galitin ang mga Anak "...do not provoke your children to anger..."

### 2. Ang Dapat Gawin: Palakihin Sila sa Panginoon

- "...but bring them up..."
- a. Sa Mapagmahal na Pagdidisiplina "...in the discipline.... of the Lord."
- b. Sa Maka-Diyos na Pagtuturo "...and instruction of the Lord."

### **HAMON**

Ang ating mga anak ay hindi natin pag-aari. Sila ay kaloob sa atin ng Panginoon para pangasiwaan ang kanilang paglaki sa kanilang pagkakilala at pagsunod sa Panginoon.

If you confess. With your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

### PRAYER

Lord Jesus, be merciful to me, a sinner. I believe that You are the Son of God who took the penalty for my sins on the Cross. I humbly ask You to be my Savior and submit to you as my LORD forever. Amen.
