Serve as Unto the Lord

EPHESIANS 6:5-8

We continue in our series of messages on that section of the book of Ephesians which many call “The Household Code” because it contains in one place (Ephesians 5:22-6:9) all of the important imperatives for a household that seeks to please God. The wider context of this passage we will look at today begins in Ephesians 5:15-18, where we are instructed to walk wisely (v. 15), to walk in the will of the Lord (v. 17), and walk under the control of the Holy Spirit (v. 18). This results in walking joyfully (v. 19), walking thankfully (v. 20), and walking in submission “to one another out of reverence for Christ” (v. 21).

We already learned previously that submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ is really the key to building households that please God: wives submitting to their own husbands as to the Lord (Ephesians 5:22-24), husbands sacrificially loving their wives as Christ loved the church (Ephesians 5:25-33), children obeying and honoring their parents in the Lord (Ephesians 6:1-3), and fathers bringing up their children in the discipline and instruction of the Lord (Ephesians 6:4).

Today, we will move to the instructions given to “bondservants” in the household:

- 1. OBEY RESPECTFULLY AS THEY WOULD CHRIST (Ephesians 6:5)**
- 2. SERVE SINCERELY AS BONDSERVANTS OF CHRIST (Ephesians 6:6-7)**
- 3. LIVE EXPECTANTLY FOR THE REWARD OF CHRIST (Ephesians 6:8)**

CHALLENGE

While these passages address servants in ancient Greco-Roman households, it is easy to see how these same principles can apply to our households today, and to anyone who is in the employ of an “earthly master.” The important principle here that is to be upheld by all of us who are in a position of service to others is that we are to serve as unto the Lord—obeying respectfully as we would Christ, serving sincerely as servants of Christ, and living expectantly for the reward of Christ. As such, our work must be of the highest quality... working as unto the Lord! ■



Maglingkod Para Sa Panginoon

EPHESIANS 6:5-8

Ating pinagpapatuloy ang serye ng mga mensahe mula sa Ephesians kung saan marami ang nagsasabi na ito ay ang “*The Household Code*” dahil nilalaman nito (Ephesians 5:22-6:9) ang lahat ng mga importanteng utos para sa isang tahananang naghahangad ng kaluguran ng Panginoon. Ang konteksto ng mensahe na ating pag-aaralan ngayon ay nagsisimula sa Ephesians 5:15-18, kung saan tayo ay tinuruan na mamuhay nang makatwiran (v. 15), sumunod sa kalooban ng Panginoon (v. 17), at magpasailalim sa Espiritu Santo (v. 18). Ito ay nagbubunga ng paglalakbay na may kasiyahan, (v. 19), pasasalamat (v. 20), at pagpapasakop sa isa’t isa bilang tanda ng paggalang kay Cristo. (v. 21)

Atin nang natutunan na ang pagpapasakop sa isa’t isa bilang tanda ng paggalang kay Cristo ay siyang susi sa pagbuo ng isang tahananang maka-Diyos: mga babaeng nagpapasakop sa sarili nilang asawa tulad ng pagpapasakop nila sa Panginoon (Ephesians 5:22-24), mga lalaking minamahal ang kanilang mga asawa nang may pagsasakripisyo tulad ng pagmamahal ni Cristo sa iglesia (Ephesians 5:25-33), mga anak na sumusunod sa kanilang mga magulang alang-alang sa Panginoon (Ephesians 6:1-3), at mga magulang na pinapalaki ang kanilang mga anak ayon sa disiplina at aral ng Panginoon (Ephesians 6:4).

Ngayon, ating pag-aaralan ang mga tagubilin na ibinigay sa mga “alipin” ng sambahayan:

- 1. SUMUNOD NANG MAY PAGGALANG GAYA NG PAGESUNOD KAY CRISTO**
(Ephesians 6:5)
- 2. MAGLINGKOD NANG MAY KATAPATAN BILANG ISANG LINGKOD NI CRISTO**
(Ephesians 6:6-7)
- 3. MAMUHAY NANG MAY KASIYAHAN PARA SA GANTIMPALA NI CRISTO**
(Ephesians 6:8)

HAMON

Itong mga mensaheng ito ay ibinigay sa mga alipin ng sinaunang Greco-Roman households, ngunit napakadaling makita kung paano natin maisasabuhay ang mga prinsipyong ito sa ating mga sambahayan ngayon at sa kahit sino man na naglilingkod sa kapwa niya tao. Ang pinakaimportanteng prinsipyo dito na dapat panindigan ng lahat na naglilingkod para sa iba ay dapat tayong maglingkod para sa panginoon - sumunod nang may paggalang gaya ng pagsunod natin kay Cristo, maglingkod nang may katapatan bilang isang lingkod ni Cristo, at mamuhay nang may kasiyahan para sa gantimpala ni Cristo. At dahil dito, dapat mataas ang kalidad ng ating paglilingkod... paglilingkod para sa Panginoon! ■

● THE GOSPEL

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures," (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)

● THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD

God is holy and righteous:

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty, the whole earth is full of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3).

He requires holiness of us

as well: "Be holy, for I am holy" (1 Peter 1:16).

● THE TRUTH ABOUT CHRIST

Christ is the expression

man reconciliation: "God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them (2 Corinthians 5:18).

● WHAT SHOULD WE DO?

Believe and receive Jesus as Lord and Savior:

If you confess, With your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

● PRAYER

Lord Jesus, be merciful to me, a sinner. I believe that You are the Son of God who took the penalty for my sins on the Cross. I humbly ask You to be my Savior and submit to you as my LORD forever. Amen.

Church Mission & Vision

GCF Metro Baguio's mission is simple, "Love God, Love Others and Make Disciples" with the vision, "As a church of Jesus Christ, GCF Metro Baguio exists to proclaim the centrality of the Gospel of Jesus Christ for life change, strengthening of families, community transformation in Baguio City, the Cordilleras and beyond, for the glory of God."

So how has the Lord inspired GCF Metro Baguio to carry out our Mission and Vision this 2022?

I. Proclaiming the Centrality of the Gospel

The proclamation of the Gospel takes shape when God's people are devoted in the study and application of His Word. This spurred the church to worship in-person starting December 2021, concluding various sermon series on Matthew, as well as Colossians. Currently, we're studying the gospel of Mark every Communion Sunday and the book of Ezra.

II. Life Change and Strengthening of Families

The church relaunched our Volunteers Fellowship with the Growth Group Leaders Training 1 and Oikos training. We have resumed our in-person Sunday School ministry as well as many ministry fellowships face-to-face and online — an open Growth Group on Thursday nights via Zoom, the monthly Men's Fellowship, and the weekly midweek Prayer Time every Wednesday night. Our Growth Groups continue to meet both online and in-person.

III. Community Transformation in Baguio, the Cordilleras, and Beyond

In its desire to reach the city, the church has been ministering to the blind community of Baguio through livelihood projects, even partnering with them in their Sunday busking along Session Road as GCF members distribute free taho to people. Furthermore, the church gave financial aid to Typhoon Odette victims in Surigao Del Norte earlier in the year. All these are done in keeping with Jesus' command to make disciples of all nations. We have been partnering with the ministries of the church's missionary members locally and abroad.
