COMMUNION SERIES ON HEBREWS: THE SUPREMACY OF CHRIST AND CHRISTIANITY OCTOBER 1-2, 2022

### Encouraged and Equipped to Live for God HEBREWS 13:20-25

Our lives as Christians may be as challenging as it was for the Hebrew believers, but this Benediction, stating truths found throughout the epistle, reveals why we should keep going in life with hope and faith. The Christian life isn't just to be endured and tolerated but enjoyed and lived with excitement and anticipation of what God can do.

This closing prayer gives three encouraging truths we must remember about how God is for us, not against us:

- 1. Our God is a God of peace because we have peace *with* God through Jesus Christ (Romans 5:1–2; Luke 2:14) and peace *from* God through the Holy Spirit (Galatians 5:22–23; Philippians 4:6-7; John 14:27).
  - Hebrews 10:22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.
- 2. Our Great Shepherd lives forever and has sealed an eternal covenant with us by His blood.
  - Hebrews 4:15-16 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
  - Hebrews 7:25 Consequently, He is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.
- 3. God has equipped us with everything needed to do His will, and His Spirit enables us to do what pleases Him.
  - Philippians 2:12–13 Work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.
  - 2 Corinthians 9:8 And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work.
  - Ephesians 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.

### **FINAL THOUGHTS**

God has equipped us to do His will and please Him, through Jesus Christ, for our good (Romans 8:28) and His glory (Hebrews 13:21 – "through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen").

The earthly life of a Christian may not be easy, but it is not impossible. We have a God of peace who is for us, a Great Shepherd who intercedes for us, and God's Spirit who dwells in us. So keep the faith in our faithful God, and remember: "Without faith it is impossible to please Him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who seek Him" (Hebrews 11:6). ■

### Kakayahang Mabuhay Para sa Diyos

HEBREWS 13:20-25

Ang buhay ng isang Kristiyano ay madalas maraming hamon. Ang pangwakas na dalanging ito, na isang basbas sa mga nakikinig, ay naglalaman ng mga araling matatagpuan sa buong sulat ng Hebrews. Isinasaad nito ang lahat ng dahilan upang tayo ay hindi manghina sa buhay espiritwal, at sa halip, ay mabuhay na may pag-asa at sigla.

Pag-aralan natin ang tatlong nakasisiglang katotohanan-na ang Diyos ay sa ating panig:

- Ang ating Diyos ay Diyos ng kapayapaan: sa pamamagitan ni Hesu Kristo mayroon tayong kapanatagan sa harapan ng Diyos (Romans 5:1-2; Luke 2:14) at kapayapaang bigay ng Banal na Espiritu (Galatians 5:22-23; Philippians 4:6-7; John 14:27).
  - Hebrews 10:22 Kaya't lumapit tayo sa Diyos nang may tapat na kalooban at matibay na pananalig sa kanya. Lumapit tayong may malinis na budhi sapagkat nalinis na ang ating mga puso.
- Ang ating Dakilang Pastol ay buhay at nagbigay sa atin ng isang walang-hanggang tipan (kasunduan).
  - Hebrews 4:15-16 Ang dakilang saserdote nating ito ay nakauunawa sa ating mga kahinaan sapagkat sa lahat ng paraa'y tinukso siyang tulad natin, ngunit hindi nagkasala. Kaya't huwag na tayong mag-atubiling lumapit sa trono ng mahabaging Diyos at doo'y kakamtan natin ang habag at kalinga sa panahong kailangan natin ito.
  - Hebrews 7:25 Dahil nga riyan, lubusan niyang maililigtas ang lahat ng lumalapit sa Diyos sa pamamagitan niya, sapagkat siya'y nabubuhay magpakailanman upang mamagitan para sa kanila.
- Binigay sa atin ng Diyos ang lahat na kailangan para gawin ang Kanyang kalooban, at ang Kanyang Espiritu ay nagbibigay-lakas sa atin upang gawin kung ano ang nakalulugod sa Kanya.
  - Philippians 2:12-13 May takot at panginginig na magpatuloy kayo sa paggawa hanggang sa malubos ang inyong kaligtasan, sapagkat ang Diyos ang nagbibigay sa inyo ng pagnanasa at kakayahang maisagawa ang kanyang kalooban.
  - 2 Corinthians 9:8 Magagawa ng Diyos na pasaganain kayo sa lahat ng bagay—higit pa sa inyong pangangailangan—upang may magamit kayo sa pagkakawanggawa.
  - Ephesians 2:10 Tayo'y kanyang nilalang, nilikha sa pamamagitan ni Kristo Hesus upang iukol natin ang ating buhay sa paggawa ng mabuti, na itinalaga na ng Diyos para sa atin noon pa mang una.

### FINAL THOUGHTS

Binigyan tayo ng Diyos ng kapangyarihan upang gawin ang Kanyang kalooban at pasayahin Siya sa pamamagitan ni Hesus; para sa ating ikabubuti (Romans 8:28) at para sa Kanyang kaluwalhatian magpakailanman (Hebrews 13:21).

Ang buhay Kristiyano ay maaaring hindi madali, ngunit hindi ito imposible. Ang Diyos ng kapayapaan ay sa ating panig, ang Dakilang Pastol ay namamagitan para sa atin, at ang Banal na Espiritu ay nananahan sa atin. Kaya patuloy lang tayong magtiwala sa Diyos, at huwag kalimutan: Hindi kinalulugdan ng Diyos ang hindi nananalig sa Kanya. Sapagkat ang sinumang lumalapit sa Diyos ay dapat maniwalang may Diyos, at Siya ang nagbibigay ng gantimpala sa mga humahanap sa Kanya (Hebrews 11:6). ■

#### THE GOSPEL

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures," (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)

#### THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD

God is holy and righteous: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty, the whole earth is full of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3). He requires holiness of us as well: "Be holy, for I am holy" (1 Peter 1:16).

THE TRUTH ABOUT CHRIST Christ is the expression of God's love for us: "God demonstrates his own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8). Christ paid the penalty of our sins and died for sinners: "For Christ died for sins once for all, righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God (1 Peter 3:18). Through Christ, God offers man reconciliation: "God was

reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them (2 Corinthians 5:18).

#### WHAT SHOULD WE DO? Believe and receive Jesus as Lord and Savior:

If you confess. With your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

#### PRAYER

Lord Jesus, be merciful to me, a sinner. I believe that You are the Son of God who took the penalty for my sins on the Cross. I humbly ask You to be my Savior and submit to you as my LORD forever. Amen.
