LESSON AIM

1. GG members will lift their concerns to God instead of worrying about them.
2. GG members will praise and thank God for the gift of His Son, Jesus Christ.
3. GG members will glorify God by discerning and doing His will.

INTRODUCTION

The author of Hebrews ended his letter with a beautiful benediction, summarizing the main points of his epistle. He showed how God made peace with us, through the death and resurrection of His Son, Jesus Christ, and God equips us with all that we need to do His will for His glory.

The God of peace, who sacrificed His Son Jesus Christ, equips believers to do His will (vv. 20-25)

1. Why did the author describe God as the God of peace?
(cf. Romans 5:1-2; Philippians 4:6-7)
2. What is the significance of Christ being raised from the dead?
(cf. Acts 4:10-12; Romans 6:4-5)
3. Why did the author describe Jesus Christ as the great shepherd?
(cf. John 10:11)
4. What is the “blood of the eternal covenant” mentioned by the author, and what is its connection with believers of Jesus Christ?
(cf. Matthew 26:27-28; Hebrews 10:19-22)
5. What has God equipped believers with? (cf. Ephesians 1:3) For what purpose did God equip them? (cf. Philippians 2:12-13; Ephesians 2:10)
6. What is the purpose why believers do God’s will? (cf. Matthew 5:16)

WORD & WALK:

Understanding & Applying the Word

Application

1. What are some things that rob you of peace? What is preventing you from allowing the peace of God to fill your mind? How can you overcome this?
2. How has Christ's death and resurrection affected you - your attitude toward life and your behavior? How can you share this life-changing experience with others?
3. How are you using your spiritual gifts to serve God and do His will? How is God glorified through your service?

Prayer Item

Spend time together praising and thanking God for the gift of His Son, Jesus Christ. Then pray for one another that each of you be fill with the peace of God, and be protected from worry and anxiety. Lift up each other's concerns to God. Pray that our church be sensitive to what God is doing in our midst so we may join Him in His work and be obedient to His will.
