

LESSON AIM

- 1. GG members will be vigilant against false teachers.
- 2. GG members will safeguard our unity in the faith.

INTRODUCTION

After warning believers against false teachers, and telling them that God will surely judge them, Jude now informs believers how they can protect themselves against these false teachers. The very first reminder he told them was that they should remember the teachings of the apostles.

Jude told believers to remember what the apostles said (vv. 17-19)

- What are the predictions of the apostles that Jude was referring to? (cf. Acts 20:29; 1 Timothy 4:1)
- 2. What did Jude mean when he described these people as:
 - a. Scoffers (cf. Jude 1:10; 2 Peter 3:3)
 - b. Following their own sinful passions (cf. Jude 1:8, 16)
 - c. Cause divisions (cf. Acts 20:30)
 - d. Worldly people (cf. Jude 1:11; 1 Corinthians 2:14)
 - e. Devoid of the Spirit (cf. Romans 8:9; 1 John 4:1)

APPLICATION

 Jude exhorted the believers to remember the teachings of the apostles to defend themselves against false teachers. What are the most important biblical truths that you hold on to and will not compromise on?

PRAYER ITEM

Pray for one another that each one will develop a personal conviction regarding fundamental biblical truths. Pray for the church that we will be united in the faith. Pray for understanding and grace so that believers can have different, even opposing opinions, while maintaining good relationships with one another.
