## Rescue Others Spiritually

### JUDE 22-23

To protect us from falling away, there are four things we can apply from the last eight verses of Jude:

- 1) Keep remembering the Apostles' teachings and guard against false teachers (Jude 17-19).
- 2) Maintain fellowship with God by building up your Biblical beliefs and praying in the power of God's Spirit (Jude 20-21).
- 3) Use every opportunity to rescue others spiritually (Jude 22-23).
- 4) Be assured by God's supremacy and sovereignty (Jude 24-25).

Jude tells us to use every opportunity to rescue others spiritually, and as we do, it helps affirm our spiritual state. Who are the people who need our help? Or perhaps, which of these describes you?

*Jude 22 "And have mercy on those who doubt."*

#### **1) The Unstable – Christians whose faith has been weakened by false teaching.**

- God wants us to show genuine love for them (Matthew 22:37-40). This may involve one or more of the following:
  - a) Praying for or with them.
  - b) Studying the Bible together and drawing pertinent insights into the person's spiritual struggles.
  - c) Bringing them to someone who can help them with their questions about the faith.
  - d) Making ways to separate them from the source of false teaching and replacing it with faithful biblical teaching.

*Jude 23a "Save others by snatching them out of the fire."*

#### **2) The Unsavd – They are in grave danger and must be rescued urgently.**

- False teaching further endangers the unsaved because it hardens them against the truth (Galatians 1:6-8).
- The only way we can snatch them out of the fire is to give them the gospel. The gospel is God's power for salvation to those who believe (Romans 1:16).

*Jude 23b "To others show mercy with fear, hating even the garment stained by the flesh."*

#### **3) The Unrepentant – The false teachers or their die-hard followers.**

- The unrepentant are to be avoided but not hated (2 Thessalonians 3:14-15). The same love should be shown to them as to unstable Christians.
- Prayer is the most important thing that can be done for them because two-way communication with them is dangerous to the immature or unequipped believer.

#### **Final Thoughts**

There is nothing passive about being a Christian. We maintain our fellowship with God by a vigilant focus on the Word of God, prayer, and living for Christ's imminent return. And this goes beyond ourselves – we reach out to bring others to a personal relationship with Christ.

As we rescue others struggling with false teaching, we affirm and strengthen our own walk with God. ■

## Ipakita ang Kahabagan ng Diyos sa Nanghihina

JUDE 22–23

Sa bawat digmaan ay palaging may mga sugatan kaya dapat tayong maging maawain sa mga nanghina sa labanan, maging sa mga nanganganib sa pagkatalo, kahit na tayo ay nagbabantay na hindi tayo masugatan.

Ang anyo ng pandiwa ng salitang “awa” ay nangangahulugang patuloy na magkaroon ng awa — maging mahabagin; upang tulungan ang isang taong nagdurusa at naghahanap ng tulong. Sinabi ni Jude na mayroon tayong awa mula sa Diyos (Jude 2). Sinabi ni Pablo na tayo ay naligtas sa pamamagitan ng awa ng Diyos (Ephesians 2:4-5) kaya dapat tayong aktibong mag-alay ng awa sa iba.

### 1. SA MGA NAGDUDUDA SA KATOTOHANAN

**“On those who doubt”**

Magkakaroon ng mga taos-pusong nagdududa na karapat-dapat sa ating habag. Ito ang mga hindi pa nakakamit ng isang matatag na paniniwala sa katotohanan ng ebanghelyo, at naaakit ng patuloy na pag-atake ng mga huwad na guro. Dapat natin silang patuloy na hanapin, manalangin para sa kanila, at magbigay ng lakas ng loob mula sa salita ng katotohanan.

### 2. SA MGA NANGHIHINA ANG PANANAMPALATAYA

**“Save others by snatching them out of the fire”**

Magkakaroon ng mga taong kumakabit malapit sa bangin ng paghatol sa pamamagitan ng pagpapakita ng kahit na kawalan ng pananampalataya o kawalang-interes sa ebanghelyo. Ang katotohanang maaari pa silang maagaw sa apoy ay nangangahulugan na hindi sila lubos na mapahamak. Habang sila ay nabubuhay kailangan natin silang ipanalangin, abutin sila, at paulit-ulit na umapela sa kanila na makipagkasundo sa Diyos (James 5:19–20).

### 3. SA MGA NAHUHULOG NA SA KAPAHAMAKAN

**“To others show mercy with fear, hating even the garment stained by the flesh.”**

Sa wakas ay may mga malamang na nasa estado na ng pagtanggap, na ginagawa silang mga kaaway ng krus, at samakatuwid ay mapanganib na makisali. Dapat pa rin nating ipagdasal sila dahil hindi natin alam ang punto ng walang pagbabalik, gayunpaman ingatan natin ang ating mga sarili upang maprotektahan ang ating sarili mula sa mantsa (Galatians 6:1–3).

### HAMON

Kaya pinayuhan tayo ni Jude na maging maawain — sa mga nag-aalinlangan, sa mga hindi naniniwala, at maging sa mga napapahamak. ■
