## Understanding & Applying the Word

#### **LESSON AIM**

- 1. GG members will thank God for His protection by their loving obedience.
- GG members will worship God and praise Him for granting them salvation from sin.

#### INTRODUCTION

In the past few lessons, we learned how we are to protect ourselves from false teachers. We are to be reminded of the apostles teachings, we are to maintain our fellowship with God, we are to show mercy to others who are influenced by false teachers. In this lesson, we see our assurance as believers that we will not fall away from the faith.

#### God preserves the purity of believers (v. 24)

- What does God protect believers from? (cf. 2 Thessalonians 3:3; 1 John 3:9)
   How have you experienced this in your life?
- 2. What else does God to do believers? (cf. Romans 8:29-30; Ephesians 5:27) How does this truth affect your daily walk with God?
- 3. Why is there reason to rejoice in the salvation, and preservation, of believers? (cf. Hebrews 12:2; 1 Peter 1:8)

#### **APPLICATION**

 Spend some time praising and thanking God for the gift of salvation (past, present, and future). In response to God's love, how are you keeping yourself in His love?

#### God is worthy of all glory, honor, and power (v. 25)

- 1. Why did Jude describe God as "the only God"? (cf. Deuteronomy 6:4; Isaiah 46:9) Can you cite some examples of other "gods" in our day and age?
- 2. How did God save us through Jesus Christ? (cf. 1 Timothy 2:3-4; Titus 3:4-6) What can we learn about God's person and character by the way He saved us?
- 3. What does God deserve because of who He is and what He has done? (cf. 1 Chronicles 29:11; Revelation 5:13)

#### **APPLICATION**

 How can you worship God at home, school, or work and give him the glory He deserves?
