INTRODUCTION

The coming of a new year always brings a lot of hope to the hearts of people, because it marks the start of a new period of time within which we can live our lives better, accomplish our goals faster, and move to our dreams closer. But the coming of a new year also brings apprehensions and anxieties because of the uncertainties and difficulties of life, and these often war against the positive aspirations of people for the new year.
