LESSON AIM

1. GG members will love one another as Christ loved them.
2. GG members will strive for unity in the local church for God's glory.

INTRODUCTION

Every local church is built up of unique people, each one distinct from the other. One would think that this diversity will bring about disunity. But this is God's design for His church. He meant for different people to come together in unity, worshiping and giving glory to Him. Let's take a look at how we can do that as a local church.

Paul instructed the church to bear with one another (vv. 1-4)

1. What did Paul mean regarding those who are "strong" and those who are "weak"? (cf. Romans 14:1-9)
2. What did Paul instruct the strong believers to do? (cf. Galatians 6:1-2)
3. Who did Paul want the believers to please? (cf. 1 Corinthians 10:24; Philippians 2:3-4) Compare this with the natural tendency of people.
4. Who did Paul point out as an example believers should copy?
5. How does scriptures help believers fulfill this obligation? (cf. 1 Corinthians 10:11)

Application

1. What challenges do you face in bearing with other believers? What are some traits God needs to further develop in your life?

Paul prayed for unity in the church (vv. 5-7)

1. What did Paul pray for regarding how believers live with each other? (cf. Romans 12:16) How would you imagine this in our day and age?
2. What is the purpose of believers being of the same mind in Christ? What impact would this have on people outside the church? (cf. John 17:20-21)

1. How are you praying for other believers in church? How are you praying for your church family?
