## The Rise of the Messiah

LUKE 2:39-52

Jesus was aware of his unique relationship with God long before He began public ministry. As a young teen, He already knew that He was God's Son and that He possessed a unique calling. See how God the Son reveals Himself to us in the major movements of the story:

### RAISING JESUS: THE SON OF MAN (Luke 2:39-42).

- **"Jesus of Nazareth"**

The name "Jesus" was so common that they had to use "Jesus of Nazareth" (Acts 2:22) to identify Him. His enemies used the title to mock Him, but Jesus used it when He spoke from heaven (Acts 22:8). What people scorn (John 1:46), God makes glorious!

- **Joseph and Mary as model parents: observe how they raised Jesus—**

*"Performed everything according to the Law of the Lord."*

*"The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom."*

*"His parents went to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover."*

### FINDING JESUS: THE SON OF GOD (Luke 2:43-50).

- **Joseph and Mary didn't fully grasp who Jesus was.**

**He had to guide and remind them.**

His parents had focused solely on His human sonship and had to be reminded of His eternal sonship (Luke 1:32, 35).

- **Jesus knew who He was. Who is He? Two key passages:**

In Luke 2:46-47: He is the amazing, supernatural Son of God.

In Luke 2:49: He is the Son who loves His Father, seeks His Father, and is committed to His Father's purpose.

### THE MODEL SON, JESUS (Luke 2:51-52).

- **Jesus honored His parents in perfect obedience to the Law (The Ten Commandments).**

Jesus is a beautiful example for our youth. He grew in every vital aspect of life (Luke 2:52), and His priority was to do the will of the Father (Matthew 6:33) while submitting to His parents (Luke 2:51).

- **Jesus grew in wisdom and favor with God and people.**

Jesus did this during an even longer eighteen "silent years": growing and developing.

### FINAL THOUGHTS

As you partake of Communion today, reflect on the rise of the Messiah from the humblest origins, who came for this singular purpose: to seek and to save us who were lost (Luke 19:10). May this continuing reminder of grace transform us into what God wants us to be, more like Jesus. ■

## Ang Pagbangon Ng Mesiyas

LUKE 2:39-52

Alam na ni Hesus ang Kanyang natatanging kaugnayan sa Diyos bago pa man Siya nagsimula sa pampublikong ministeryo. Sa Kanyang kabataan, alam na Niyang Siya ay Anak ng Diyos at mayroon Siyang kakaibang tungkulin. Ating tingnan kung paano ipinahayag ng Diyos Anak ang Kanyang sarili sa atin sa mga pangunahing sandali ng kwento:

### ANG PAGPAPALAKI KAY HESUS: ANG ANAK NG TAO (Luke 2:39-42).

- **“Jesus of Nazareth”**

Ang pangalang “Jesus” ay napaka karaniwan kaya kinailangan nilang gamitin ang “Jesus of Nazareth” (Acts 2:22) para makilala Siya. Ginamit ito ng Kanyang mga kaaway para kutyain Siya, ngunit ginamit ito ni Jesus nang magsalita Siya mula sa langit (Acts 22:8).

Kung ano ang kinukutya ng mga tao (John 1:46) ay siyang ginagawang maluwalhati ng Diyos!

- **Sina Jose at Maria bilang mga huwarang magulang: pagmasdan kung paano nila pinalaki si Hesus—**

*“Performed everything according to the Law of the Lord.”*

*“The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom.”*

*“His parents went to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover.”*

### ANG PAGHAHANAP KAY HESUS: ANG ANAK NG DIYOS (Luke 2:43-50).

- **Hindi lubos na naunawaan nina Jose at Maria kung sino si Hesus.**

**Kinailangan Niyang gabayan at paalalahanan sila.**

Ang Kanyang mga magulang ay nakatuon lamang sa Kanyang pagiging anak bilang tao at kailangang ipaalala sa kanila ang Kanyang pagiging Anak na walang hanggan (Luke 1:32, 35).

- **Alam ni Hesus kung sino Siya. Sino nga ba Siya? Narito ang dalawang mahahalagang sipi:**

Sa Luke 2:46-47: Siya ang kahanga-hangang supernatural na Anak ng Diyos.

Sa Luke 2:49: Siya ang Anak na nagmamahal sa Kanyang Ama, naghahanap sa Kanyang Ama, at nakatuon sa layunin ng Kanyang Ama.

### ANG PINAKA-HUWARANG ANAK, SI HESUS (Luke 2:51-52).

- **Pinarangalan ni Hesus ang Kanyang mga magulang sa ganap na pagsunod sa Kautusan (Ang Sampung Utos).**

Si Hesus ay isang magandang halimbawa para sa ating mga kabataan. Lumaki siya sa bawat mahahalagang aspeto ng buhay (Luke 2:52), at ang Kanyang priyoridad ay gawin ang kalooban ng Ama (Matthew 6:33) habang nagpapasakop sa Kanyang mga magulang (Luke 2:51).

- **Si Hesus ay lumago sa karunungan at pabor sa Diyos at sa mga tao**

Ginawa ito ni Jesus sa loob ng mas mahabang labinalong “tahimik na taon”: lumalaki at umuunlad.

### PANGWAKAS NA KAISIPAN

Sa iyong pakikibahagi sa Komunyong ngayon, iyong pag-isipan ang pagbangon ng Mesiyas mula sa pinakamababang pinagmulan, na dumating para sa natatanging layuning ito: hanapin at iligtas tayong mga nawala. (Luke 19:10). Nawa ang patuloy na paalala ng biyayang ito ay baguhin tayo patungo sa kung ano ang nais ng Diyos para sa atin, na maging mas katulad tayo ni Hesus. ■

### THE GOSPEL

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures," (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)

### THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD

**God is holy and righteous:** "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty, the whole earth is full of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3).  
**He requires holiness of us as well:** "Be holy, for I am holy" (1 Peter 1:16).

### THE TRUTH ABOUT CHRIST

**Christ is the expression of God's love for us:** "God demonstrates his own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8). **Christ paid the penalty of our sins and died for sinners:** "For Christ died for sins once for all, righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God (1 Peter 3:18).  
**Through Christ, God offers man reconciliation:** "God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them (2 Corinthians 5:18).

### WHAT SHOULD WE DO?

**Believe and receive Jesus as Lord and Savior:** If you confess, With your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

*Lord Jesus, be merciful to me, a sinner. I believe that You are the Son of God who took the penalty for my sins on the Cross. I humbly ask You to be my Savior and submit to you as my LORD forever. Amen.*
