THE ONE ANOTHER COMMANDS OF THE BIBLE APRIL 15-16, 2023

Speak the Truth in Love

Like Hebrews 10:25, the "one another" here is implied rather than stated explicitly. But this implicit mandate is one of the most important because it takes the summative principle of "love one another" and joins it with "speaking the truth". Applying this "one another" in the Church results in one of the most important ethical guidelines in the New Testament.

We will frame our study in the form of three questions:

WHAT IS SPEAKING THE TRUTH IN LOVE? (Ephesians 4:15)

- "Speaking the truth" is literally "truthing it." The phrase "in love" is added as the
 motive and method of "speaking the truth." So, "truthing in love" means maintaining
 truth in love in both speech and life, motive and method.
- Love is the lifeblood of the Church. Therefore, the ultimate criterion for evaluating the Church's growth will be how much it is characterized by love (1 Corinthians 13).

WHY SHOULD WE SPEAK THE TRUTH IN LOVE?

- It is essential for our personal growth to Christlikeness. The verb about growing into Christ is a first-person command "Let us grow up in every way into Christ."
- It is essential for the unity of the Church. The phrase "in love" occurs three times in Ephesians 4 (Ephesians 4:2, 15-16), pointing to how our unity is maintained.
- It is essential for the growth of the Church (Ephesians 4:16). The reality of gifts for every Christian in the Church makes us dependent on one another. As each of us fully uses his gifts for the growth of the body, the Church grows together in Christ.

HOW DO WE SPEAK THE TRUTH IN LOVE?

- The "truth" here is specific Biblical truth, the Word of God. Speak the Word of God out of love. We must know God's Word so that God's wisdom guides our lives and our speech.
- But the principle itself applies to many situations. As 1 Corinthians 13:6 reminds us: [Love] does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. Truth can hurt. That is why truth should never be by itself. The primary principle is love, which should motivate and accompany truth. As the saying goes, "Truth without love is brutality, but love without truth is hypocrisy."

FINAL THOUGHTS

The Church needs to be the place where people can speak the truth in love and hear it spoken to them in love. Let our giving the Word to each other be driven by love, and let our love be exercised without compromising the truths of God's Word. ■

THE ONE ANOTHER COMMANDS OF THE BIBLE APRIL 15-16, 2023

Magsabi Ng Katotohanan Nang May Pag-ibig EPHESIANS 4:15-16

Gaya ng Hebrews 10:25, ang "one another" dito ay ipinahiwatig sa halip na direktang ipinahayag. Ngunit ang ipinahiwatig na utos na ito ay isa sa pinakamahalaga dahil pinagsama nito ang pangkalahatang prinsipyo ng "magmahalan sa isa't isa" at ang "pagsasabi ng katotohanan." Ang pagsunod nito sa Iglesia ay nagreresulta sa isa sa pinakamahalagang mga alituntunin sa Bagong Tipan.

Atin itong pag-aralan sa pamamagitan ng tatlong tanong:

1. ANO ANG PAGSASABI NG KATOTOHANAN NANG MAY PAG-IBIG? (Ephesians 4:15)

- Ang "speaking the truth" ay literal na "pagsasabi ng katotohanan." Ang phrase
 na "nang may pag-ibig" ay idinagdag bilang motibo at paraan ng "pagsasabi ng
 katotohanan." Kaya ang ibig sabihin ng "pagsasabi ng katotohanan nang may
 pag-ibig" ay pagpapanatili ng katotohanan sa pag-ibig sa lahat ng aspeto:
 sa pananalita at buhay, sa motibo at pamamaraan.
- Ang pag-ibig ang buhay ng Iglesia. Samakatuwid, ang pinakasukdulang pamantayan para sa pagsusuri ng paglago ng Iglesia ay kung gaano ito nailalarawan sa pamamagitan ng pag-ibig (1 Corinthians 13).

2. BAKIT DAPAT MAGSABI NG KATOTOHANAN NANG MAY PAG-IBIG?

- Ito ay mahalaga para sa ating personal na paglago sa pagiging katulad ni Kristo.
- Ito av mahalaga para sa pagkakaisa ng Iglesia.
- Ito ay mahalaga para sa paglago ng Iglesia (Ephesians 4:16).

3. PAANO MAGSABI NG KATOTOHANAN NANG MAY PAG-IBIG?

- Ang "katotohanan" dito ay tiyak Biblikal na katotohanan, ang Salita ng Diyos.
 Ipahayag natin ang Salita ng Diyos mula sa pag-ibig. Dapat nating malaman ang Salita ng Diyos upang magabayan tayo ng karunungan ng Diyos sa ating buhay at pananalita.
- Ngunit ang prinsipyo mismo ay nalalapat sa maraming sitwasyon. Gaya ng ipinaaalaala sa atin ng 1 Corinthians 13:6 ukol sa pag-ibig: "Hindi ito natutuwa sa masama, sa halip ay nagagalak sa katotohanan." Masakit ang katotohanan. Ang pangunahing prinsipyo ay pag-ibig na dapat mag-udyok at sumabay sa katotohanan. Gaya nga ng kasabihan, "Ang katotohanan na walang pag-ibig ay kalupitan, ngunit ang pag-ibig na walang katotohanan ay pagkukunwari."

THE GOSPEL

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures," (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)

THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD

God is holy and righteous: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty, the whole earth is full of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3). He requires holiness of us as well: "Be holy, for I am holy" (1 Peter 1:16).

THE TRUTH ABOUT CHRIST

Christ is the expression of God's love for us: "God demonstrates his own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8). WHAT SHOULD WE DO? Believe and receive Jesus as Lord and Savior:

If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).
