COMMUNION SERIES ON LUKE: GOD THE SON, SON OF MAN MAY 6-7, 2023

Is There Any Good in Genealogies? LUKE 3:23-38

People value roots when long-term relationships (e.g., marriage) are in mind. Similarly, knowing Jesus' origins confirms His credentials—something crucial in an eternal relationship with (or without) Him.

What good is there in reflecting on Jesus' origins? What realizations help us worship God better and grow in grace further?

1. THE TIMING OF GOD IS PERFECT (Luke 3:23a)

²³ Jesus, when He began [His ministry], was about thirty years of age,

- Jesus functioned as Priest, Prophet, and King in fulfilling prophecy about the Messiah. And 30 was the usual age for entering these offices: Priest (Numbers 4:3); Prophet (Ezekiel 1:1); King (Genesis 41:46; 2 Samuel 5:4).
- Imagine the Savior of the world as a carpenter in a small town until 30. He patiently trusted God's timing for His life. Are you wondering and waiting for your next step? Don't jump ahead—ask God and wait for His timing.

2. THE WAYS OF GOD ARE PERFECT (Luke 3:23b-37)

^{23b} being the son (as was supposed) of Joseph.

- Luke stressed that Joseph was not Jesus' biological father. His being Son of God rests on His
 virgin birth. This genealogy confirms it and provides Jesus' verification in the world where He
 would fulfill His mission.
- By tradition, people traced genealogies through the father. This was a problem for a virgin birth! So, Luke followed Mary's line – Jesus' *biological* lineage (Matthew followed Joseph's line, His *legal* lineage by adoption). That's another reason why Luke had to say, "the son (as was supposed) of Joseph."
- Jesus has the proper roots to be the promised Messiah:
 - He is David's descendant, pointing to a royal lineage and fulfillment of prophecy.
 - He is Abraham's descendant, fulfilling the promise to Abraham.
 - He is Adam's descendant, relating Him to all humanity.
 - Above all, Jesus is the Son of God. God created this line to culminate in Jesus.

3. THE REDEMPTIVE PLAN OF GOD IS PERFECT (Luke 3:38)

³⁸ ...the son of Adam, the son of God.

- Luke ultimately relates Jesus to Adam and God. He is the offspring to crush Satan's head (Genesis 3:15). This shows the universal offer of salvation emphasized by Luke's Gospel— Jesus is a Savior for all nations, not just Israel (Luke 2:32).
- Linking Jesus to Adam shows God's plan to save humanity through one Man (Galatians 4:4–5).
 - The REDEEMER of sinners must be fully human (Hebrews 2:14-15).
 - The MEDIATOR for sinners must be fully human (Hebrews 2:17, 1 Timothy 2:5).
 - The HELPER of sinners must be fully human (Hebrews 2:18).
 - The SACRIFICE for sinners must be a sinless and perfect human (Hebrews 10:4–7, 11–12).

FINAL THOUGHTS

Jesus' genealogy ties all humanity into one unit. Our fate is wrapped up in Jesus. His genealogy confirms His calling and His ministry's comprehensive character. Like this saying from the early church says: Jesus, the Son of God, became a son of Adam so that the sons of Adam could become sons of God. ■

May Mabuti Ba Sa Mga Talaangkanan?

Pinahahalagahan natin ang pinagmulan ng ating kapwa pagdating sa mga pangmatagalang relasyon. Ang pag-alam sa pinagmulan ni Hesus ay nagpapatunay sa Kanyang mga kredensyal—isang bagay na mahalaga sa isang walang hanggang relasyon sa Kanya.

Ano ang pakinabang sa pagninilay-nilay sa pinagmulan ni Hesus? Anong mga realisasyon ang tutulong sa atin na sambahin ang Diyos nang mas mahusay at mas lumago sa biyaya?

1. ANG PANAHON NG DIYOS AY PERPEKTO (Luke 3:23a)

THE TIMING OF GOD IS PERFECT

²³ Magtatatlumpung taon na si Jesus nang siya'y magsimulang mangaral.

- Si Hesus ay gumanap bilang Pari, Propeta, at Hari sa pagtupad ng hula tungkol sa Mesiyas (Numbers 4:3, Ezekiel 1:1, Genesis 41:46; 2 Samuel 5:4).
- Matiyaga Siyang nagtiwala sa oras ng Diyos para sa Kanyang buhay. Iniisip mo ba at hinihintay kung ano ang iyong susunod na hakbang? Huwag magmadali—magtanong sa Diyos at hintayin ang Kanyang oras.

2. ANG MGA DAAN NG DIYOS AY PERPEKTO (Luke 3:23b-37)

THE WAYS OF GOD ARE PERFECT

²³⁶ Ipinapalagay ng mga tao na siya'y anak ni Jose.

- Ang Kanyang pagiging Anak ng Diyos ay nakasalalay sa Kanyang birhen na kapanganakan. Ang genealogy na ito ay nagpapatunay nito at nagbibigay ng pagpapatunay ni Hesus sa mundo kung saan Niya tutuparin ang Kanyang misyon.
- Ayon sa tradisyon, ang mga tao ay nagtutunton ng mga genealogy sa pamamagitan ng ama. Ito ay isang problema para sa isang birhen na kapanganakan! Kaya, sinundan ni Luke ang linya ni Mary—ang biyolohikal na angkan ni Hesus (sinunod ni Matthew ang linya ni Joseph, ang Kanyang ligal na lahi sa pamamagitan ng pag-aampon). Iyan ang isa pang dahilan kung bakit kailangang sabihin ni Luke, *"the son (as was supposed) of Joseph."* (ESV)
- Si Hesus ay may ugat upang maging ang ipinangakong Mesiyas.

3. ANG PLANONG PAGTUBOS NG DIYOS AY PERPEKTO (Luke 3:38)

THE REDEMPTIVE PLAN OF GOD IS PERFECT

³⁸ anak ni Adan na anak ng Diyos.

- Sa huli ay iniugnay ni Luke si Hesus kay Adan at sa Diyos. Si Hesus ay isang Tagapagligtas para sa lahat ng bansa, hindi lamang sa Israel (Luke 2:32).
- Ang pag-uugnay kay Hesus kay Adan ay nagpapakita ng plano ng Diyos na iligtas ang sangkatauhan sa pamamagitan ng isang Tao (Galatians 4:4–5).

HAMON

Ang genealogy ni Hesus ay nag-uugnay sa lahat ng sangkatauhan sa isang unit. Ang ating kapalaran ay nakabalot kay Hesus. Ang Kanyang genealogy ay nagpapatunay sa Kanyang tungkulin at sa malawak na katangian ng Kanyang ministeryo. Tulad ng kasabihang ito mula sa unang simbahan: *Si Hesus, ang Anak ng Diyos, ay naging anak ni Adan upang ang mga anak ni Adan ay maging mga anak ng Diyos.* ■

THE GOSPEL

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures," (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)

THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD

God is holy and righteous: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty, the whole earth is full of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3). He requires holiness of us as well: "Be holy, for I am holy" (1 Peter 1:16).

THE TRUTH ABOUT CHRIST Christ is the expression of God's love for us: "God demonstrates his own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8). Christ paid the penalty of our sins and died for sinners: "For Christ died for sins once for all, righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God (1 Peter 3:18). Through Christ, God offers man reconciliation: "God was reconciling the world to himself

in Christ, not counting men's sins against them (2 Corinthians 5:18).

WHAT SHOULD WE DO? Believe and receive Jesus as Lord and Savior:

If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).
