ENGLISH MESSAGE OUTLINE

THE ONE ANOTHER COMMANDS OF THE BIBLE MAY 27-28, 2023

Use Your Freedom and Gifts to Serve One Another

GALATIANS 5:13; 1 PETER 4:10

Why are Christians to serve one another? In Galatians 5:13, the Apostle Paul gives us the first reason: because we have been freed to serve one another through love. And in 1 Peter 4:10, Peter gives us the second reason: because we have been given spiritual gifts to serve one another as good stewards of God's varied grace.

Main truth: Believers are called to use their freedom in Christ and spiritual gifts to serve one another through love.

- 1. Freed to Serve One Another: Believers are called to use their freedom not to sin but to serve one another through love. (Galatians 5:13)
 - a. Believers have been freed from sin, not to sin. (Galatians 5:13)
 - o Believers have freedom because Christ has set them free. (Galatians 5:1)
 - Believers are not to use their freedom to gratify the flesh. (Galatians 5:13b)
 - Believers are to walk by the Spirit so they will not gratify the desires of the flesh.
 (Galatians 5:16: 17, 22–23)
 - Believers are to use their freedom to serve one another through love. (Galatians 5:13b)
 - Love is the motivation and means to serve one another. (Galatians 5:14, 1 Corinthians 13:4-6)
 - Love is also the fruit of the Spirit. (Galatians 5:22–23)
 - Believers are to follow the Golden Service Rule, the Golden Rule (Matthew 7:12) applied to service: "Serve one another as you would have others serve you."
- 2. Gifted to Serve One Another: Believers are called to be good stewards of God's varied grace by using their spiritual gifts to serve one another. (1 Peter 4:10)
 - a. The Gift: Every believer has received a spiritual gift. (1 Peter 4:10)
 - The Command: Every believer is to use his spiritual gift to serve other believers as a good steward of God's varied grace. (1 Peter 4:10)
 - Scripture passages on spiritual gifts (1 Peter 4:11, Ephesians 4:11-12, Romans 12:6–8, 1 Corinthians 12:8–10)
 - c. The Purpose: In everything God may be glorified through Jesus Christ. (1 Peter 4:11)

Gamitin Ang Inyong Kalayaan at Mga Kaloob Para Maglingkod Sa Isa't Isa

GALATIANS 5:13; 1 PETER 4:10

Bakit dapat paglingkuran ng mga Kristiyano ang isa't isa? Sa Galatians 5:13, ibinibigay sa atin ni Apostol Pablo ang unang dahilan: dahil tayo ay pinalaya upang maglingkod sa isa't isa sa pamamagitan ng pag-ibig. At sa 1 Peter 4:10, ibinibigay sa atin ni Pedro ang pangalawang dahilan: dahil tayo ay binigyan ng mga espiritwal na kaloob upang maglingkod sa isa't isa bilang mabubuting katiwala ng iba't ibang biyaya ng Diyos.

- Pinalaya Upang Paglingkuran ang Isa't Isa: Ang mga mananampalataya ay tinawag na gamitin ang kanilang kalayaan hindi para magkasala kundi maglingkod sa isa't isa sa pamamagitan ng pag-ibig. (Galatians 5:13)
 - a. Ang mga mananampalataya ay napalaya na mula sa kasalanan, hindi para magkasala. (Galatians 5:13)
 - o Ang mga mananampalataya ay may kalayaan dahil pinalaya sila ni Kristo. (Galatians 5:1)
 - Ang mga mananampalataya ay hindi dapat gamitin ang kanilang kalayaan upang bigyangkasiyahan ang laman. (Galatians 5:13b)
 - Ang mga mananampalataya ay dapat lumakad sa pamamagitan ng Espiritu upang hindi nila matugunan ang mga pagnanasa ng laman. (Galatians 5:16; 17, 22-23)
 - b. Dapat gamitin ng mga mananampalataya ang kanilang kalayaan upang maglingkod sa isa't isa sa pamamagitan ng pag-ibig. (Galatians 5:13b)
 - Ang pag-ibig ang motibasyon at paraan para pagsilbihan ang isa't isa. (Galatians 5:14, 1 Corinthians 13:4-6)
 - o Ang pag-ibig ay bunga rin ng Espiritu. (Galatians 5:22-23)
 - o Ang mga mananampalataya ay dapat sumunod sa Ginintuang Alituntunin sa Paglilingkod, ang Ginintuang Alituntunin (Matthew 7:12) na ikinakapit sa paglilingkod: "Paglingkuran ninyo ang isa't isa kung paanong ibig ninyong paglingkuran kayo ng iba."
- Biniyayaan Upang Paglingkuran ang Isa't Isa: Ang mga mananampalataya ay tinatawag na maging mabubuting katiwala ng iba't ibang biyaya ng Diyos sa pamamagitan ng paggamit ng kanilang mga espirituwal na kaloob upang maglingkod sa isa't isa. (1 Peter 4:10)
 - a. Ang Kaloob: Ang bawat mananampalataya ay nakatanggap ng espirituwal na kaloob. (1 Peter 4:10)
 - Ang bawat mananampalataya ay binigyan ng espirituwal na kaloob ng Banal na Espiritu para sa kabutihang panlahat. (1 Corinthians 12:7)
 - Ang Banal na Espiritu ay naghahati-hati sa bawat isa ayon sa Kanyang kalooban.
 (1 Corinthians 12:11)
 - Ang Utos: Ang bawat mananampalataya ay dapat gamitin ang kanyang espirituwal na kaloob upang maglingkod sa ibang mga mananampalataya bilang isang mabuting katiwala ng iba't ibang biyaya ng Diyos. (1 Peter 4:10)
 - Mga talata sa Bibliya tungkol sa mga espirituwal na kaloob (1 Peter 4:11, Ephesians 4:11-12, Romans 12:6-8, 1 Corinthians 12:8-10)
 - c. Ang Layunin: Sa lahat ng bagay ay luwalhatiin ang Diyos sa pamamagitan ni Hesu Kristo. (1 Peter 4:11)

THE GOSPEL

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures," (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)

THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD

God is holy and righteous:
"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord
Almighty, the whole earth is full
of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3).
He requires holiness of us
as well: "Be holy, for I am holy"
(1 Peter 1:16).

THE TRUTH ABOUT CHRIST

Christ is the expression of God's love for us: "God demonstrates his own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8). Christ paid the penalty of our sins and died for sinners: "For Christ died for sins once for all, righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God (1 Peter 3:18).

Through Christ, God offers man reconciliation: "God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them (2 Corinthians 5:18).

WHAT SHOULD WE DO? Believe and receive Jesus as Lord and Savior:

If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

As one of the pastors to the youth of our church, it is my joy to share with you how the Lord has led **YouthLIVE** to build up and reach out.

Since the latter half of 2022, we have been driving from Ortigas to the mountaintops of Baguio and the valleys of Bicol to visit other GCF churches and fellowship with them. Each "Kapwa" visit has shown us glimpses of eternity — people from different geographical and cultural backgrounds coming together to worship the same God. There is much joy and humility in discovering that we in Ortigas are not the only ones who want to know Christ and make Him known. Through random hangouts, overflowing food, and heart-to-heart conversations, our desire is to build bridges and friendships with our *Kapwa* believers to encourage the next generation to build up the Kingdom of God together, hand in hand.

Likewise, our effort to reach out to the campuses is our **Frontline Ministry**. Now that schools have resumed face-to-face classes, the campus as a mission field has become physically accessible again. We praise God for leading four of our homegrown youth (now young adults) to become missionaries in this field. We are looking to the Lord for guidance as we head into the next school year so more students may live out what it means to be church in the frontlines — their campuses.

In less than two weeks, we will be having our first **Frontline Camp** since the pandemic and it will be geared towards college students. This camp will have a vastly different approach from the previous Youth Camps. Please pray not only for the campers from GCF Ortigas, but also those from our *Kapwa* churches and outreaches — that they may witness and experience the living *Logos* (Jesus Christ) in their minds, hearts, and lives. ■
