FATHER'S DAY MESSAGE

The Dad Who Follows God (Mordecai) SELECTED VERSES FROM ESTHER

In a book where God is never mentioned, the central figures were followers of God. Most of all, the fingerprints of God are written on every page of this hauntingly beautiful narrative that proves God watches over His people. And all of this because an old man, upon whom fatherhood was imposed, led his young daughter in a way that all fathers can learn from:

1. The Dad Who Follows God joyfully accepts fatherhood – even if he may feel unqualified or unworthy (Esther 2:5–7).

- Mordecai, the much older cousin of beautiful Esther, had fatherhood imposed on him. This story is replicated with the entry of every child in a father's life. Nobody is really prepared to be a dad!
- Dad, don't undervalue the good you can do as you personally follow God.

2. The Dad Who Follows God raises children by his character (Esther 3:1-6).

- Mordecai showed his true character when he refused to bow down to a self-inflated man, because his primary loyalty was to God (Deuteronomy 5:6-9).
- Character is more often caught than taught. Our children don't always follow what
 we say, but they will follow what we do. Dad, always be conscious of this, and how
 much you need God to get this right.

3. The Dad Who Follows God helps his children live for God (Esther 4:13-17).

- Mordecai asked Esther to realize that a Divine hand was moving behind the scenes, who would make sure His people ended well.
- When you have the opportunity to be heard by your kids, dad, make sure what you say is from God, about God, and for God. There's no better way to be sure that what you are saying is right.
- All of us, both children and dads, must realize this: anyone who follows God unashamedly will always live significantly. We learn this from Esther's life.

FINAL THOUGHTS

Always trust the sovereignty of God. That's what the whole book of Esther is about. This same sovereign God gave a dad who follows God the assignment of fatherhood. As you take this role and live for God, so will your family. May it always be so, by God's grace.

FATHER'S DAY MESSAGE

Ang Tatay Na Sumusunod Sa Diyos (Mordecai) SELECTED VERSES FROM ESTHER

Sa isang aklat ng Biblia na walang kahit na isang banggit ng Diyos, ang mga sentral na karakter ay mga tagasunod ng Diyos. Higit sa lahat, bakas ang kamay ng Diyos sa bawat pahina nitong kamangha-manghang salaysay na ito na nagpapatunay na palaging nagbabantay ang Diyos sa Kanyang mga hinirang. At ito ay dahil sa isang matandang lalaki na biglang naging tatay, na pinamunuan ang kanyang nakababatang anak-anakan sa isang paraan na dapat tularan ng lahat ng ama.

- Ang lalaking sumusunod sa Diyos ay may galak na tatanggapin ang pagiging ama kahit na hindi siya karapat-dapat sa kanyang paningin (Esther 2:5-7).
 - Si Mordecai, na mas nakatatandang pinsan ni Esther, ay biglang naging ama. Sa isang banda, ang salaysay na ito ay totoo sa lahat ng ama na dinadatnan ng isang anak.
 Wala namang tunay na handa na maging ama.
 - Mga ama, huwag ninyong tawaran ang kabutihan na magagawa ninyo sa inyong tapat na pagsunod sa Panginoon.
- 2. Ang ama na sumusunod sa Diyos pinalalaki ang kanyang mga anak sa pamamagitan ng kanyang karakter (Esther 3:1-6).
 - Ipinakita ni Mordecai ang kanyang karakter nung hindi siya lumuhod sa isang makasariling tao, sapagkat ang kanyang pangunahing katapatan ay sa Diyos (Deuteronomy 5:6–9).
 - Ang karakter ay mas natutunan sa tamang halimbawa, kaysa sa pagtuturo. Hindi laging sumusunod ang ating mga anak sa ating tinuturo, ngunit sila ay susunod sa ating halimbawa. Mga ama, lagi nating isa-isip ito, at laging humingi ng tulong sa Diyos.
- Ang ama na sumusunod sa Diyos ay tutulungan ang kanyang mga anak na mamuhay para sa Diyos (esther 4:13-17).
 - Ipinamukha ni Mordecai kay Esther na ang kamay ng Diyos ang nasa likod ng lahat, upang tiyakin ang kabutihan ng Kanyang mga hinirang.
 - Mga ama, sa bawat pagkakataon, tiyakin ninyo na ang inyong sasabihin ay mula sa Diyos, tungkol sa Diyos, at para sa Diyos. Wala nang mas mabuting paraan para matiyak na ang sasabihin ninyo ay tama.
 - Dapat nating kilalanin ang katotohanang ito: ang lahat na susunod sa Diyos na hindi Siya kinahihiya, ay laging mabubuhay nang may kabuluhan. Ito ang mensahe ng Esther.

HAMON

Lagi nating pagtiwalaan ang soberanya ng Diyos. Yan ang buod ng buong aklat ni Esther. Itong Diyos na ito ay nagtalaga sa isang ordinaryong tagasunod Niya na maging ulirang ama. Mga ama, sa inyong pagiging ama, mabuhay kayo para sa Diyos, at ang inyong pamilya ay susunod. Nawa ito ay maging totoo sa lahat ng mga ama. ■
