Instruct One Another

ROMANS 15:14, COLOSSIANS 3:16 a

When you hear the word “instruction” and “admonish” mentioned in the context of the church, you probably think of the leaders of your Church. Obviously, a Pastor or an Elder should be “able to teach” “sound doctrine” (1 Timothy 3:2; Titus 1:9). But the Bible also teaches that all believers are to instruct one another as stated in our Scripture references in Romans 15:14 and Colossians 3:16a. So the principle of 2 Timothy 2:2 holds true to all!

LESSON: Instructing One Another is anchored on our relationship with Christ who gives us His goodness, His Word, and equips us by His Spirit.

Consider the following three ways in which all believers are called to instruct one another:

1. To Instruct One Another - Honor Your Character (Romans 15:14a).

- In Christ: “I myself am satisfied about you, my brothers”
- “That you yourselves are full of goodness”
- Excuse No. 1: “I’m not good enough.”
- Our goodness is not earned—it is imputed or credited to us in Jesus.
- So if you are in Christ: YOU ARE GOOD ENOUGH!

2. To Instruct One Another - Study Your Message (Romans 15:14b).

- You are filled with all Knowledge
- 1 Timothy 4:6 - We can teach others to know and love sound doctrine.
- Excuse No. 2: “I don’t know enough.”
- As Christians we have everything we need to help one another grow and change in order to become more like Jesus Christ (Romans 8:29).
- Our knowledge comes through the Holy Spirit and is rooted in the Word of God.

3. To Instruct One Another - Consider Your Ability (Romans 15:14c).

- Able to Teach
- The Lord commands His people to instruct others in how to fulfill the great commission in many ways.
- Older folks are called to instruct younger believers.
- Proverbs 19:27 - REMINDERS OF THE VALUE OF TEACHING.
- In Christ, you are full of goodness and knowledge so that you are able to instruct.
- God has given us a community, a family of brothers and sisters, who know Him!

FINAL THOUGHTS

We are all still a Work in Progress! As a part of the body of Christ, you have been given different gifts to help the body grow and mature. God has designed us to teach and learn from one another as part of our commission of discipleship. I pray that God would open many opportunities to teach one another, bringing glory to Him, bringing joy to yourself, and growing our fellow believers. ■

ROMANS 15:14, COLOSSIANS 3:16 a

ARAL: Ang pagtuturo sa isa't isa ay Haligi ng ating ugnayan kay Kristo na Siyang nagbigay ng Katuwiran, ng Salita, at Kakayanan sa Tulong ng Espiritung Banal.

1. UPANG MAKAPAGTURO SA ISA'T ISA: BIGYANG KARANGALAN ANG IYONG PAGKATAO (Romans 15:14a).

- Kay Kristo: "Ako mismo ang lubos na naniniwala, mga kapatid ko"
- "Na kayo'y punung-puno ng kabutihan"
- Unang Dahilan: "Hindi ako sapat na mabuti."
- Ang ating kabutihan ay hindi nakukuha sa pamamagitan ng gawa natin—ito ay binibilang o inilalagak sa atin sa pamamagitan ni Hesus.
- Kaya kung ikaw ay na kay Kristo: **IKAW AY SAPAT NA MABUTI!**

2. UPANG MAKAPAGTURO SA ISA'T ISA: PAG-ARALANG MABUTI ANG IYONG MENSAHE (Romans 15:14b).

- Ikaw ay puno ng buong kaalaman.
- 1 Timothy 4:6 - Pwede tayong magturo sa iba upang malaman at mahalín nila ang tamang doktrina.
- Pangalawang Dahilan: "Hindi ako sapat na may alam."
- Bilang mga Kristiyano, mayroon tayo ng lahat ng ating kakailanganin upang tulongan ang isa't isa na lumago at magbago upang maging katulad ni Hesu Kristo (Romans 8:29).
- Ang ating kaalaman ay nagmumula sa Banal na Espiritu at nagmumula sa Salita ng Diyos.

3. UPANG MAKAPAGTURO SA ISA'T ISA: PAGTIBAYIN ANG IYONG KAKAYANAN (Romans 15:14c).

- May kakayahan na magturo sa isa't isa.
- Iniutos ng Panginoon sa Kanyang mga tao na ituro sa iba kung paano tuparin ang dakilang misyon sa maraming paraan.
- Ang mga mas matatanda ay tinatawag na turuan ang mga mas bata na mananampalataya.
- Proverbs 19:27 - **PAALALA TUNGKOL SA HALAGA NG PAGTUTURO.**
- Sa pamamagitan ni Kristo, ikaw ay puno ng kabutihan at kaalaman upang makapagturo.
- Binigyan tayo ng Diyos ng isang pamayanan, isang pamilya ng mga kapatid na kilala Siya!

THE CHARACTER OF GOD

God is holy, pure, and just. He rightfully and righteously judges and punishes all sin.

“Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory! (Isaiah 6:3)

Who will not fear you, O Lord, and glorify your name? For you alone are holy. (Revelation 15:4)

THE CRISIS WE FACE

We all have failed God's standard and face God's righteous judgment.

“For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God... (Romans 3:23)

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth. (Romans 1:18)

THE CALL OF JESUS

The Lord Jesus is God's only way for us to be forgiven and reconciled to God. He took the judgment for our sins on the Cross, and whoever comes to Christ for forgiveness, He gives new life and an eternal relationship with God.

“Jesus said “I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.” (John 14:6)
