# Be Humble With One Another 1 PETER 5:5-7

Coming from a context of what spiritual leaders ought to be, Peter instructs everyone inside the church family to be humble with one another:

# WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE CLOTHED WITH HUMILITY TOWARD OTHERS?

It is to wear a servant's attire and be down to earth with people. Two things to know about humility:

**The Attitude:** Humility is being aware of our insufficiency but trusting in Christ's allsufficiency (2 Corinthians 3:5). It doesn't mean putting yourself down but thinking of others more than yourself (Philippians 2:3-4).

The Outcome: The outcome of humility is joyful service to others (Mark 9:35; 10:45).

# WHY SHOULD WE BOTHER WITH HUMILITY IN THE FIRST PLACE?

## 1. God resists the proud.

God hates pride. It was the first sin in history, making both Lucifer and humanity fall. Most of all, pride is a personal insult to God because it is self-worship, the idolatry of self. There's no worse nightmare than to have an infinitely powerful and holy God against you.

## 2. God exalts the humble.

God will use His mighty hand to exalt you in His perfect time (1 Peter 5:6). God will use His mighty hand to care for you personally (1 Peter 5:7). Humility is a declaration of dependence that opens your life to receive grace. There's no greater blessing than to have an infinitely powerful and wise God caring for you.

# HOW DO I CLOTHE MYSELF WITH HUMILITY?

Verse 7 is a subordinate clause to the command in verse 6 and can be read this way: "Humble yourselves under God's mighty hand by casting all your anxieties on Him, and God will exalt [*promote*] you in His perfect time. He cares about you [*your welfare is personal to Him*, Psalm 55:22]."

The more you trust in God, the humbler you become. The root of anxiety is a form of pride that says, "I believe in my problems more than God." Faith, therefore, destroys both pride and anxiety.

# **FINAL THOUGHTS**

God resists the proud, but He can't resist the humble. He will pour grace into their lives. Can you trust God until the time He comes through for you? "I will humble myself in peace and joy as I trust this precious and great promise of God—He cares for me." — John Piper ■

- a. Mapagpakumbaba at mapagsakripisyong paglilingkod (1 Peter 5:1-4)
- b. Mabuting halimbawa ng buhay na may pananampalataya (Hebrews 13:7)

# 2. ANG PANAWAGAN NA MAGPASAKOP AT MAGPAKUMBABA

"Likewise, you who are younger..."

- Magpasakop v. 5, "be subject to the elders" (Hebrews 13:17; 1 Peter 2:13, 2:18, 3:1, 7)
- b. Magpakumbaba v. 5, "Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another"
  - Maging parang alipin (John 13:4-5, 14-15)
  - Maging tama ang tingin sa sarili (Romans 12:3,16; 2 Corinthians 3:5)
  - Maging mataas ang tingin sa iba (Philippians 2:3; Romans 12:10)
  - Maglingkod sa isa't isa (Philippians 2:4; Matthew 20:26)

# 3. ANG PAKINABANG NG PAGIGING MAPAGPAKUMBABA

- a. Ang pagpapala ng Diyos v. 5, "for 'God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."
  - Hindi para sa palalo (Isaiah 14:12-15; Ezekiel 28:17)
  - Kundi para sa nagpapakumbaba (James 4:6; Proverbs 3:34)
- b. Ang pagtataas ng Diyos v. 6, "Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you"
  - Magpasailalim sa paghahari ng Diyos (James 4:10; Matthew 23:12)
  - Magpataas sa kapangyarihan ng Diyos (Isaiah 57:15)
- c. Ang pangangalaga ng Diyos v. 7, "casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you"
  - Ibigay sa Kanya ang ating mga pagkabalisa (Psalm 55:22)
  - Tanggapin ang Kanyang pagkalinga (Matthew 6:25–32)

Ang pagiging mapagpakumbaba ay nag-uugat sa pagpapasakop natin sa paghahari at pamamahala ng Diyos. Sa Kanyang pagliligtas at paglingap sa atin, maitatama natin ang tingin natin sa ating sarili upang ating maitaas naman ang tingin natin sa iba. Tinatanggihan Niya ang nagmamataas, ngunit hindi Niya matatanggihan ang nagpapakumbaba. Sa halip, Kanya pa ngang bibiyayaan sila, itataas at aalagaan. ■

# **Doing Ministry the "Jesus Way"**

All churches desire to create an environment for men to grow in their relationships, spiritual journeys, and leadership capacities. The "why" is obvious. There simply are not enough men leaders who are all-in and full-on for Jesus. Churches are looking for *more* from their men — more participation, more depth, more passion, more commitment.

Let's learn from how Jesus did it:

- 1. Jesus hand-picked a few guys. While He had more than twelve followers, He focused His time and energy on the Twelve.
- They walked through life together. This Core of Twelve learned from Jesus along the way, through real-life and real-time situations.
- 3. Jesus prayed with them and for them. He also taught them how to pray.
- 4. Jesus spoke Scripture, explained Scripture, and lived Scripture.
- 5. The Twelve made huge time commitments. They left everything behind to follow Jesus.
- 6. Theirs was a community, with Jesus as their leader. The Twelve knew each other intimately and developed close bonds.
- 7. Jesus poured into the Twelve over three and a half years. There was a defined period of time. After which, He "graduated" them and sent them out to do the work.

If all these seem familiar, it is because Jesus modeled for us what "small group discipleship" looks like. This is the roadmap we hope to adopt in the **Men's Ministry**, in support of the church's Assimilation Process.

We have started our Growth Group Express for Men every Sunday from 8:30 to 10:00 AM at Room B117. We invite all men who are looking to grow with other men to join us. Come to bless and be blessed.
