Do Not Lie to One Another

COLOSSIANS 3:9–10; EPHESIANS 4:25

“Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator.” - Colossians 3:9–10

“Therefore, having put away falsehood, let each one of you speak the truth with his neighbor, for we are members one of another.” - Ephesians 4:25

Purpose Statement: This sermon reminds believers in GCF that, in Christ, they positionally have put off their old selves and have put on their new selves and that they are all members of one another. They, therefore, are to heed the biblical command to not lie but instead speak the truth.

I. The Command: Do not lie, Speak the truth

“Do not lie to one another” (Colossians 3:9a)

“Let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor,” (Ephesians 4:25b)

II. The Cognitions: “Seeing that...” “For...”

A. Cognition #1 — The Old Self has been put off

“you have put off the old self with its practices” (Colossians 3:9b)

B. Cognition #2 — The New Self has been put on

“and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator.” (Colossians 3:10)

C. Cognition #3 — Believers are members one of another

“we are members one of another.” (Ephesians 4:24c)



Filipino Message Outline

THE ONE ANOTHER COMMANDS OF THE BIBLE

Huwag Magbulaan sa Isa't Isa COLOSSIANS 3:9-10; EPHESIANS 4:25

Walang pakinabang sa atin ang magbulaan sa isa't isa. Nakakasira ito ng pagtitiwala, pagkakaisa, at pagkakasundo sa ating kapatiran. Bilang taga-pamahayag ng katotohanan, hindi naaayon sa pagtawag ng Panginoon sa atin ang magbulaan sa kahit na anong pagkakataon. At higit sa lahat, dahil tayo ay ipinanganak na muli ng Panginoon at taglay na natin ang pagbabagong diwa na mula sa Espiritu Santo, hindi na tayo dapat nagbubulaan at nagsisinungaling, at lalo na sa isa't isa. Sa halip, dapat tayong magsalita ng katotohanan sa lahat ng pagkakataon.

1. ANG KAUTUSAN: HUWAG MAGBULAAN, KUNDI MAGSALITA NG KATOTOHANAN

a. Malinaw sa Bibliya na hindi dapat nagsisinungaling ang mga hinirang ng Diyos, na nananampalataya sa Kanya

"Do not lie to one another..." (Colossians 3:9; Exodus 20:16; Leviticus 6:2-3; 19:11; Psalm 15:1-3; John 8:44; Revelation 21:8)

b. Malinaw din sa Bibliya na dapat lang magsalita ng katotohanan sa lahat ng pagkakataon

"Therefore, having put away falsehood, let each one of you speak the truth with his neighbor..." (Ephesians 4:25; Psalm 15:2; Proverbs 12:17; Zechariah 8:16; Ephesians 4:15)

2. ANG KADAHILANAN: TAYO AY BINAGO NA NG PANGINOON AT MAGKAKAUGNAY SA KANYA

a. Meron tayong tunay na pagbabagong buhay

"...seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices... and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator" (Colossians 3:9-10; 3:1-4; Romans 6:4; Galatians 2:20; Ephesians 2:5-6; Colossians 2:12)

b. Meron tayong tunay na pakikibahagi ng isa't isa

"...for we are members one of another" (Ephesians 4:25b; Ephesians 4:4-6; Romans 12:5; 1 Corinthians 12:12-13, 25-26)

Sa huli, kailangan umiral sa atin ang pag-ibig para sa isa't isa, na iniutos at inilarawan ni Kristo Hesus (John 13:34-35). At ang pag-ibig na iyan ay Kanya nang ipinagkaloob sa lahat ng Kanyang ipinanganak na muli at binago (Romans 5:5). Ito ang kalakasan na dapat nag-uudyok sa atin na huwag magbulaan sa isa't isa at laging maging makatotohanan sa isa't isa. ■

Beatitudes DMG-2 Sermon Series

Praise God for the work that volunteers and leaders put into the recently concluded big events of DMG-2 — DVBS of KidsLIFE, the High School and Frontline (college) Camps of YouthLIVE, and the YA Retreat happening this weekend. As part of our follow-up plans, we're preparing to have a sermon series that's designed to help kids, youth, and young adults remember the basics of who Jesus is through the Sermon on the Mount, especially its introduction — the Beatitudes.

Through prayer, the team sees the Beatitudes to be a good way to explain Christianity in a short, simple way. When you look at the whole Gospel of Matthew, it's easy to see that it's all about Jesus' discourses and speeches. The main message of all discourses is about what God's Kingdom is and how both Jews and Gentiles can join it (Radmacher and Allen 1507). The Beatitudes come at the beginning of one of Matthew's most important discourses, The Sermon on the Mount. The Beatitudes is a summary of the entire sermon (Fernando, Packer, and Grudem 1326). It's a short list of ways to be a radical follower of Jesus. It is, then, a perfect brief follow-up sermon series for the many new people who joined our community after our big events. The Beatitudes are still and always will be a good reminder to all Christians about how to live like Jesus.

We thank God for Pastor Mikee Sosmeña and Zk Edeza for producing the sermon series, study notes, and reflections for DMG-2 weeks in advance. The materials they made can help teachers and preachers communicate the verses easily to kids, youth, and young adults. May the Holy Spirit move in the hearts and minds of those who will continue to hear His Word at YA Fridays, YouthLIVE services, and KidsLIFE Sunday School! ■

THE CHARACTER OF GOD

God is holy, pure, and just. He rightfully and righteously judges and punishes all sin.

“Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory! (Isaiah 6:3)

THE CRISIS WE FACE

We all have failed God's standard and face God's righteous judgment.

“For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God... (Romans 3:23)

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth. (Romans 1:18)

THE CALL OF JESUS
