#### **LESSON AIM**

To understand the Centrality of Christ in Ministry both to an unbelieving world and to the churches

#### INTRODUCTION

The Apostle Paul emphasized the centrality of Christ to the faith of the Colossian believers and explained why Christ is central to his ministry. Essentially, He has been entrusted with the spreading of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, who is the mystery that the Colossian believers have placed their trust in. Despite the fact that Paul has yet to see the faces of his readers, his affection and devotion to them are evident in this passage of scripture.

## The Apostle Paul encouraged the Colossian believers to continue in their faith by realizing that they have reconciliation with God by Christ (vv. 1:21–23).

- How were the Colossians described by the Apostle Paul prior to their reconciliation by Christ? (v. 1:21a)
- 2. By what act of Christ were the believers reconciled? (v. 1:21b-22a)
- 3. How did the apostle Paul desire that the Colossian believers be presented as by Christ's sacrifice? (v. 1:22b)
- Clearly, the Colossians were already saved (reconciled), and their salvation
  was secure, so they would certainly be presented to God. But what is the
  condition for being presented as holy, blameless, and above reproach before
  God? (v. 1:23)

## **Application:**

How have you been tempted to give up on the Christian life? What keeps you moving forward?

## II. The Apostle Paul revealed that he was steward of the mystery of Christ (vv. 1:24–27)

- 1. What was the Apostle Paul's attitude regarding suffering for the Colossian believers? (v. 1:24)
- 2. What was the purpose of the Apostle Paul's stewardship from God? (v. 1:25)
- 3. What is that thing that has been hidden for ages and generations but is now revealed to the believers? (v. 1:26)
- 4. This mystery is exactly what? (v. 1:27)

#### **Application:**

What kind of paradigm is necessary for us in this day and age to look at suffering with rejoicing? Why else do you think that suffering can be a source of rejoicing?

# III. The Apostle Paul revealed his desire that he present the Colossian believers as mature in Christ (vv. 1:28–29).

- 1. Who is it that the Apostle Paul and the other apostles proclaimed in their ministry? (v. 1:28)
- 2. What were the means by which the Apostle Paul can present the believers at Colossae as mature in Christ? (v. 1:28)
- 3. What was the source of power for the Apostle Paul in his ministry? (v. 1:29)

### **Application:**

What areas in your Christian life do you think God can still teach and admonish you toward Christ-likeness?

## IV. The Apostle Paul encouraged the Colossian believers to grow in their knowledge of Christ even as they were praised for their steadfastness in Christ. (vv. 2:1–5)

- Apparently the Apostle Paul had yet to visit the church at Colossae and Laodicea as well, and yet he was experiencing struggle for them. Why do you think he was struggling for them? (v. 2:1)
- 2. There were three things that the Apostle Paul was striving for the churches. Can you identify them? (v. 2:2)
- How is Christ described in verse 2:3?
- 4. What was Paul's purpose for describing Christ clearly? (v. 2:4)
- 5. Despite Paul's not being physically present, in what manner was he present? And what was his state of mind? (v. 2:5)

## **Application:**

In what manner can you communicate Christ clearly to others? First for unbelievers, then for believers?
