LESSON AIM

- GG members will know that the varieties of gifts and ministries are from the same Spirit of God.
- GG members will also learn the nature and purpose of gifts as given by the Holy Spirit.
- 3. GG members will be taught to use these gifts not for self-indulgence, nor the abuse of Christian freedom, but for the love and edification of the church.
- GG members enabled and empowered by the Holy Spirit to be an active participant in God's world mission to bring the message of salvation to all peoples

INTRODUCTION

It appears evident that there was a question on the nature of spiritual gifts, and how these are being exercised in the Corinthian church which Paul tried to clarify.

Paul taught that all spiritual gifts come from the Holy Spirit (vv. 4-8)

- 1. Who is the giver and enabler of Spiritual gifts of believers and what are these gifts? For what purpose is the manifestations of these gifts? (vv. 4, 7-8)
- 2. Who gave the various ministries of the church, who do all these ministries serve? (v. 5)

Paul taught that the Church is the unified body of Christ (vv. 11-18)

- 1. How can you discern the will of God for you when you are given a specific spiritual gift? (v. 11)
- 2. How can the church be unified when it is composed of different people with different gifts? (vv. 12-13)
- 3. What did Paul compare the members of Christ body to? What is their relation to one another? (vv. 14-18)
- 4. How can we, as Christ's body, be instrumental in partnering with God in His global mission?
