THE ONE ANOTHER COMMANDS OF THE BIBLE

Encourage One Another

1 THESSALONIANS 4:18

Various circumstances can lead to discouragement among Christians, causing anxiety about the future and a lack of energy to uplift each other. However, the sacrifice Christ made on the cross provides a solid foundation for our faith and a hopeful future, motivating us to encourage each other.

I. In Christ...Our Hope for a Bright Future is <u>Assured</u> (1 Thessalonians 4:18)

When Christ returns, believers will be saved from God's wrath at the tribulation, to be reunited with their departed Christian loved ones and to be with God forever (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; 1 Corinthians 15:51-53; Romans 11:29).

II. In Christ...Our Hope for a Bright Future will come Anytime (1 Thessalonians 5:1-11)

Christ's coming that signals the end times is imminent. As Christ could return and might return at any time, we are to be prepared for Him to come at any day (1 Thessalonians 5: 1-11; Hebrews 3:13).

Failure or lack of preparations will result in two things: apostasy or falling away from God (Hebrews 3:13) and unfruitfulness in our Christian journey (1 Thessalonians 4:1-3; Ephesians 1:4; John 15:1-11; 2 Corinthians 5:10).

The solution? Put on the full armor of God, especially those that protect the vital parts: our full assurance of faith and love and our hope of salvation from tribulation (Ephesians 6:10-18; 1 Thessalonians 5:8).

III. In Christ...Our Hope for a Bright Future is <u>Assembled</u> in His Church (1 Thessalonians 5:12-24; Hebrews 10:25)

Our love for each other is best expressed in the church. This includes our attitude towards our leaders, our relationships with each other, and our individual and collective behavior.

Regular church attendance and active participation in various ministries foster love for one another. The church serves as a place for reminders and exhortations to persevere as we anticipate the Lord's return.

Final Thoughts

We sometimes find ourselves in situations that may discourage us in the present and make us anxious about the future. Take heart and be steadfast. We have a God who is faithful to His promises concerning our present and our future (Romans 11: 29). We have ample reason to **Encourage One Another** in our hope in Christ Jesus. ■

Hikayatin Natin Ang Isa't Isa

1 THESSALONIANS 4:18; HEBREWS 10:25

Mahirap ang buhay Kristiyano at marami tayong sinasalubong na mga hamon sa ating mundo at kultura. Bilang isang iglesia na nagtatapat sa ating pagtatalaga kay Kristo Hesus, pahirap nang pahirap ang manindigan sa Kanya. Hindi tayo kailangan manlupaypay at manghina. Mayroon tayong isang tiyak at buhay na pag-asa na nakasandig sa ating kinabukasan kay Kristo at sa kaligtasan na Kanyang tinamo para sa atin.

1. DAHIL SA KATIYAKAN NG ATING KINABUKASAN KAY KRISTO (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18)

- a. Dahil hindi tayo katulad ng iba na walang pag-asa (v. 13)
- b. Dahil ang ating Panginoon ay binuhay na maguli, ang lahat ng nauna ay bubuhayin Niya muli (v. 14-16)
- c. Dahil tiyak na kukunin ng Panginoon ang Kanyang hinirang at niligtas sa pisikal na kamatayan (v. 17)

2. DAHIL SA KADAKILAAN NG ATING KALIGTASAN KAY KRISTO (Hebrews 10:19-25)

- Kaligtasan na nagbigay sa atin ng bagong daan patungong langit (v. 19-20)
- b. Kaligtasan na dapat mag-udyok sa atin na lalong palaguin ang ating pananampalatava (v. 21-25a)
 - Dahil mayroon tayong dakilang Tagapamagitan kay Hesus...
 - Lalo tayong lumapit sa ating kaugnayan sa Panginoon (v. 22)
 - Lalo tayong kumapit sa ating pinaniniwalaan tungkol sa ating pag-asa sa Kanya (v. 23)
 - Lalo tayong magtipon bilang isang kapatiran upang palaguin ang ating pag-iibigan at paggawa ng mabuti (v. 24-25a)
- c. Kaligtasan na dapat mag-udyok sa atin na hikayatin ang isa't-isa (v. 25b)

Hamon

Tapat ang ating Diyos sa Kanyang mga hinirang. Tinutupad Niya palagi ang lahat ng Kanyang mga pangako sa lahat ng Kanyang niligtas kay Kristo Hesus (John 6:39-40). Maaaring dumaranas tayo ngayon ng mga paghihirap at pagsubok na dala ng kahirapan sa ekonomiya, hamon sa kalusugan, problema sa ating mga relasyon, at marahil, pagpanaw ng ating mga minamahal sa buhay (1 Peter 4:12-13). Bilang magkakapatid kay Kristo Hesus, hikayatin natin ang isa't-isa dahil mayroon tayong buhay na pag-asa, tiyak na kinabukasan, at dakilang kaligtasan sa Kanya.
