THE ONE ANOTHER COMMANDS OF THE BIBLE

Confess to One Another

JAMES 5:14-16

Has God given a blanket promise that prayer guarantees healing? Why is there disease in the first place? Why weren't famous faith healers emptying COVID wards during the lockdown? Our passage helps us answer these questions.

THE CONSEQUENCE OF SIN (v. 14a)

Some aspects of the theology of sin and sickness:

- The Fall introduced sin and its consequences to humanity, including premature physical death and illness (Genesis 2:16-17).
- 2. Many but not all diseases are directly related to sin (John 5:14).
- 3. Some diseases are for the glory of God, not because of sin in the sufferer (John 9:3).
- James 5:14 shows that spiritual and emotional weakness (asthenei) may cause or aggravate physical conditions that resolve according to God's will in response to prayer.

THE COMFORT OF LEADERS AND FELLOW BELIEVERS (vv. 14b, 16)

How does the faith community (the church) help one another regarding sin and weakness?

- <u>Call for the elders:</u> their ministry is to pray in faith and counsel the struggling believer toward repentance if necessary (v. 14b).
- Confess your sins to one another and pray for one another (v. 16).
 Guidelines for confessing to one another (from A Theology of Christian Counseling by Dr. Jay Adams)
 - Confession is first and foremost to God (1 John 1:9) and only then to others.
 - Avoid highly connotative language. Use factual terms and be as brief as possible (Proverbs 10:19).
 - Don't destroy good words by bad attitudes (Proverbs 25:11). Confession should be done for the right reason.
 - d. Guard against ruining a confession by describing the other person's sin accusingly.
 - e. Don't attach excuses to confession.

THE CONSEQUENCES OF PRAYER AND CONFESSION (vv. 15-16)

- 1. The prayer of faith will save the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up.
- 2. If he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.
- 3. Confessing to one another and praying for one another leads to spiritual healing.

FINAL THOUGHTS

Why does confessing to one another give spiritual healing? Because the earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results. Prayer is not magic. But its power is unlimited because the Christian calls on a Father of infinite love and power.

Magtapatan Kayo Sa Isa't Isa

JAMES 5:14-16

Talaga bang ginarantiya ng Diyos ang paggaling ng lahat ng ating sakit? Kung gayon, bakit marami pa rin ang may sakit? Nasaan kaya ang mga naturingang "faith healers" noong may COVID pandemic? May kasagutan sa mga tanong na ito sa ating pag-aaralan na teksto sa hapong ito.

ANG BUNGA NG KASALANAN (v. 14a)

llang aspeto ng doktrina tungkol sa kasalanan at karamdaman:

- 1. Ang pagkahulog ng tao sa kasalanan ay nagbunga ng pagpasok ng karamdaman at kamatayan sa sangkatauhan (Genesis 2:16-17).
- 2. Hindi palaging kasalanan ang diretsong sanhi ng ibang karamdaman (John 5:14).
- Ang ibang karamdaman ay para sa kaluwalhatian ng Diyos, hindi dahil sa kasalanan ng may karamdaman (John 9:3).
- Ipinapakita ng James 5:14 na ang kahinaang espirituwal at emosyonal (asthenei) ay maaaring pagalingin ng Diyos bilang tugon sa panalangin na ayon sa Kanyang kalooban (1 John 5:14-15).

ANG KAALIWAN NG MGA PINUNO AT MANANAMPALATAYA (vv. 14b, 16)

Paano magtutulungan ang magkakapatid sa pananampalataya na nakakaranas ng kasalanan at kahinaan sa kanilang kalagitnaan?

- Magtawag ng mga Namumuno: kanilang paglilingkod ang manalangin at magpayo sa mga nanghihina, tungo sa pagsisisi kung kinakailangan (v. 14b).
- 2. Magtapatan kayo at ipanalangin ang isa't isa (v. 16).

Mga alituntunin (mula sa A Theology of Christian Counseling ni Dr. Jay Adams)

- Ang pagtatapat ng kasalanan ay, una sa lahat sa Diyos (1 John 1:9), at pagkatapos, sa iba.
- lwasan ang mga pasaring na pananalita. Maging makatotohanan at matuwid (Proverbs 10:19).
- Magkaroon ng tamang pag-uugali sa inyong pag-uusap (Proverbs 25:11).
 Magtapatan kayo na may tamang dahilan.
- d. Sa pagtatapat sa isa't isa, huwag maging maparatang sa inyong pananalita.
- e. Huwag kabitan ng pagdadahilan ang pagtatapat sa isa't isa.

ANG BUNGA NG PANANALANGIN AT PAGTATAPATAN SA ISA'T ISA (vv. 15-16)

- Ang panalangin na may pananampalataya ay magliligtas sa may sakit, at siya ay ibabangon ng Panginoon.
- Ang magtapat ng pagkakasala ay patatawarin.
- Ang pagtatapatan at pananalangin sa isa't isa ay magbubunga ng kagalingang espirituwal.

HAMON

Bakit nagdadala ng kagalingang espirituwal ang pagtatapatan sa isa't isa? Dahil ang mataimtim na panalangin ng mga matuwid ay may kapangyarihan at nagbubunga ng maganda. Hindi magic ang pananalangin. Ngunit ang Diyos Amang nasa langit na dinadalanginan natin ay may walang hanggang kapangyarihan at pag-ibig. ■
