LESSON AIM

- 1. Members will get to see the love and kindheartedness of Jesus as He preaches the Word of God for people to repent and follow Him.
- Members will understand that it is not a person's credentials that qualify him/her to become a disciple of Jesus; but an attitude of humility and obedience.
- 3. Members will know the meaning of "being fishers of men".

INTRODUCTION

Beginning His ministry for which He came into the world, and after being questioned on His authority, Jesus demonstrated this authority by His power of first teaching and healing, and also casting out demons (Luke 4:31-40). Jesus would next demonstrate His authority in calling for ordinary men into full-time discipleship.

What Does the Bible Say?

- Why did a huge crowd come to Jesus while He was standing by the Sea of Galilee? (Luke 5:1)
- 2. What were the reasons Jesus got into Simon's boat? (Luke 5:3-4)
- 3. How did Peter address Jesus? What was his response to the command of Jesus? What can you observe from his reply? (Luke 5:5)
- What happened when Peter followed and obeyed Jesus' command? What was his reaction and those of his fellow fishermen? (Luke 5:6-10a)
- 5. Why did you think Jesus told them, "Do not be afraid"? What would they be catching instead of fish, and what does it mean? (Luke 5:10b)
- 6. What was the outcome of these fishermen after they had seen the miracle Jesus did and the power that He possessed? (Luke 5:11)

WORD & WALK: Understanding & Applying the Word

Application

We are all called to be disciples of Jesus, and by this, it is meant that we are to always heed the commands of Jesus; what He tells us to do in both the capacity and ability that He has given to us.

We cannot rely on our efforts, nor should we think that we are qualified and capable simply because of our knowledge and experience, but to trust God as He directs our path, so that in whatever we do, the outcome will be to God's glory.


PRAYER ITEM
