LESSON AIM

- 1. Members will understand what inerrancy of the Bible means.
- 2. Members will be taught that the Bible is the inspired Word of God written by men and carried by the Holy Spirit.
- 3. Members will know why it is important to believe in the inerrancy of the Bible.

INTRODUCTION

The Westminster Confession of Faith, 1.4 states that "The message of the Bible is God's message to man, communicated 'in many and various ways' (Hebrews 1:1) and finally incarnated in Christ. Thus, 'The authority of the holy scripture, for which it ought to be believed and obeyed, depended not upon the testimony of any man or church, but wholly upon God (who is truth itself), the author thereof; therefore, it is to be received, because it is the word of God."

The doctrine of inerrancy of the Bible?

- 1. Why is inerrancy of the Bible an important doctrine?
- 2. What makes the Bible claim that it is inerrant and without error in the original manuscript?
- 3. What is meant by divine inspiration? To whom was it revealed and for what purpose?
- 4. How does it affect the way we read, understand, and obey what the Bible teaches?

What happens when we deny the inerrancy of the Bible?

- Denying the inerrancy of the Bible could mean that God's Word is not totally trustworthy.
- 2. It can mean that standard of truth is not from God but from our own knowledge or experience of truth.
- 3. It will cause us to doubt all other doctrines to be truthful.
- 4. We can just opt to discard anything that the Bible says and follow our own ways.
