The Greatest Gift: Salvation by Faith Alone, in Christ Alone

ROMANS 4:1-5; 4:16-5:2

The tradition of giving gifts at Christmas is said to originate from the gifts the Three Wise Men gave Jesus. But many don't realize God Himself gave the greatest gift of all time: "God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16). Why is it so crucial for us to know and believe that when it comes to salvation, we are saved by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone?

1. THE EXAMPLE OF SALVATION BY FAITH ALONE: ABRAHAM (Romans 4:2-5: 16-22)

- Paul used Abraham to teach the doctrine of justification by faith alone, apart from works. What is justification? Justification is an instantaneous legal act of God where:
 - 1. He **counts** our sins as forgiven and Christ's righteousness as belonging to us.
 - 2. He **declares** us righteous in His sight.
 - (Adapted from Systematic Theology by Wayne Grudem).
- What is faith? It is to be (v. 21) "fully convinced that God was able to do what He
 had promised." Faith is the means through which salvation is given, not an act that
 earns us favor with God. We are justified solely because of the merits of Christ's work
 (Romans 5:17–19).

2. THE EFFECTOR OF SALVATION BY FAITH ALONE: JESUS CHRIST (Romans 4:23–5:2)

- Saving faith involves the following:
 - Believing what God says in His Word about Jesus Christ (the Gospel).
 - 2. Acknowledging my sins that made me need Christ's death on the Cross on my behalf.
 - 3. I must decide to trust Jesus to save me personally.
- Scripture puts repentance and faith together as different aspects of the one act of coming to Christ for salvation (Acts 20:21). When we turn to Christ for salvation, we are simultaneously turning away from the sins that we are asking Christ to save us from.

3. THE EFFECT OF SALVATION BY FAITH ALONE: WE ARE JUSTIFIED (Romans 5:1-2)

- Paul enumerates some of the blessings of being justified by faith:
 - Peace with God (assurance).
 - 2. Access into grace by which we stand (perseverance).
 - Rejoicing in hope (endurance, 5:3–5).

Galatians 2:16 sums it up well: "We know that a person is not justified by works of the law, but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified."

No one is saved by works. No one is saved even by faith *plus* works. We are saved purely by faith alone, in Christ alone, and, therefore, by grace alone. That is the greatest gift you can ever receive. Have you received this from God? ■

Ang Pinakadakilang Regalo:

Kaligtasan sa Pamamagitan ng Pananampalataya Lamang, Kay Kristo Lamang

ROMANS 4:1-5; 4:16-5:2

Ang kaugalian ng pagbibigayan ng regalo ay nagmula raw sa mga tatlong hari na nagregalo kay Hesus. Ang hindi alam ng karamihan ay ito — ang ating Diyos ang nagbigay ng pinakadakilang regalo sa lahat: "God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16). Bakit ba napakahalaga na paniwalaan natin, na pagdating sa kaligtasan, tayo ay maliligtas lamang sa pamamagitan ng grasya ng Diyos, sa pamamagitan ng pananampalataya kay Kristo lamang?

1. ANG HALIMBAWA NG KALIGTASAN SA PANANAMPALATAYA LAMANG: ABRAHAM (Romans 4:2-5: 16-22)

- Si Abraham ang halimbawa ng pagiging justified sa pamamagitan ng pananampalataya lamang, na hiwalay sa gawa. Ito ay isang aksyon ng Diyos kung saan:
 - Pinapatawad Niya ang ating mga kasalanan dahil sa ganap na pagbabayad-sala ni Hesus sa Krus.
 - 2. Dinideklara Niya tayong matuwid dahil sa walang sala na buhay ni Hesus. (Adapted from *Systematic Theology* by Wayne Grudem).
- Ano ba ang pananampalataya? Ito ay pagiging (v. 21) "fully convinced that God was able to do what He had promised." Ang pananampalataya ay ang paraan ng kaligtasan, hindi isang gawain para makamit ang pabor ng Diyos. Ang lahat ay magiging matuwid lamang dahil sa kumpletong gawa ni Hesus (Romans 5:17–19).

2. ANG MAY-LIKHA NG KALIGTASAN SA PAMAMAGITAN NG PANANAMPALATAYA LAMANG: SI HESU KRISTO (Romans 4:23-5:2)

- Ang nakaliligtas na pananampalataya ay:
 - 1. Paniniwala sa sinasabi ng Biblia tungkol kay Hesus.
 - 2. Pagtanggap ng ating pagiging makasalanan na kinailangan ng Tagapagligtas.
 - 3. Pagpasya na tanggapin ang kaligtasan ng Diyos para sa ating sarili.
- Ang pagtalikod sa kasalanan at pananampalataya kay Hesus ay dalawang aspeto ng nag-iisang akto ng paglapit kay Hesus (Acts 20:21).

3. ANG EPEKTO NG KALIGTASAN SA PAMAMAGITAN NG PANANAMPALATAYA LAMANG: ANG PAGIGING JUSTIFIED (Romans 5:1-2)

- Ang mga biyaya ng pagiging justified:
 - Kapayapaan sa mata ng Diyos (assurance).
 - 2. Pagpasok sa Kanyang kagandahang-loob (perseverance).
 - Pagiging galak dahil sa buhay na pag-asa (endurance, 5:3-5).

Ang Galatians 2:16 ay malinaw: "We know that a person is not justified by works of the law, but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified."

Walang maliligtas sa gawa. Wala ring maliligtas ng pananampalataya at gawa. Tayo ay maliligtas sa pamamagitan ng pananampalataya lamang, kay Kristo lamang, na dahil sa grasya ng Diyos lamang. Yan ang pinakadakilang regalo. Natanggap niyo na ba ito? ■

The Lord Jesus is calling out to us: "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." (Matthew 11:28–30)
