## New Year's Eve Message Outline

# Light of a New Dawn

Preparing for 2024 brings times of looking forward with new goals and aspirations while also looking back on God's faithfulness in 2023. How should our relationship with Jesus affect our outlook on the new year? What does it truly mean to follow Jesus? In John 21, the gospel writer records a moment Jesus had with His disciples to help them remember what that means. In today's passage, we see how following Jesus should be active and intentional.

#### 1. Jesus Re-enacts the Disciples' Calling (John 21:1-14)

- What would this bring to the disciples' minds? The disciples found themselves
  in a similar situation as they did when Jesus first called them to be fishers of men
  (Luke 5:2–11). This would remind them of their original calling from Jesus to reach
  out to others with the Gospel message the way Jesus did.
  - → This incident will also remind the disciples that they need to depend on Jesus' leading, much like how we have to also depend on God in all we do (Proverbs 3:5–6)

#### 2. Jesus Refocuses Peter's Passion (John 21:15-19)

- Where is Peter's passion focused? Jesus asks Peter about his love for Jesus, bringing to mind how, at the last supper, Peter claimed he would not fall away and was willing to go to prison and even die for Jesus (Luke 22:33, Matthew 26:33–35). Mirroring how Peter denied Jesus three times in the courtyard, Jesus asks Peter if he loves Him three times also. Through this, Jesus shows Peter that his love for Him should be refocused on how he loves and takes care of the Lord's flock. Ultimately, it is about following Jesus.
  - How are we to love? We are reminded that Jesus told them during the last supper that the way disciples are to love others is by loving them the same way Jesus loved us (John 13:34–35). We are to build others up the way Jesus did.
  - How are we to follow? Jesus told Peter that he would end up dying in a way that will glorify God as a martyr. Do we follow Jesus only if it is easy or do we follow Jesus because we can glorify Him?

#### 3. Jesus Reminds Peter to Focus on Following Him (John 21:20–25)

- What does it mean to follow Jesus? Following Jesus should not be dependent on what happens to us or what God's plan is for others. Like Joshua, our choice to follow God should not be influenced by others (Joshua 24:15).
- Was Peter the only one called to take care of God's sheep? We know that Jesus
  called all of His disciples to follow Him. We have to remember that we are one of
  many who are following God. We have to build up and reach out together.

#### **FINAL THOUGHTS**

This coming 2024, let us remember our calling from the Lord to follow Him. Like Peter, we are to follow Jesus actively and intentionally. This means we are to follow Jesus by loving God, loving others, and do so even if we are the only ones. ■
