COMMUNION SERIES ON LUKE: GOD THE SON, SON OF MAN

The Savior of Outcasts

LUKE 5:27-32

What would you find if you were to take a spiritual microscope and peer into the heart of Jesus? What makes His heart tick? You will find a heart full of love for those that humankind finds hard to love; sinners. See how this is demonstrated in the salvation of Levi:

Luke 5:27–28: THE CALL OF LEVI. Repentance is offered to all, including the outcasts.

 Levi (also called Matthew) was a publicly hated tax collector who probably heard from Jesus while He preached and taught in Capernaum. In God's perfect time, Jesus finally calls him to Himself: "Follow Me." And leaving everything, he rose and followed Him.

Luke 5:29: THE CELEBRATION OF LEVI. Repentance results in a life that is excited about Jesus for others.

 Levi held a grand celebration for Jesus and ensured that "a large company of tax collectors and others" met and ate with Him.

Luke 5:30: THE CONCERN OF THE SELF-RIGHTEOUS. Repentance is incomprehensible to those who have never experienced it.

 One way to undermine another is to destroy his credibility with those who work with Him. This shows how unrepentant and blinded the "religious experts" were about the heart of God because they never really knew Him. It is easy to profess faith and allegiance to God and convince people, but you will know them by the fruit of their words and life.

Luke 5:31–32: THE CALL OF JESUS. "I have not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance."

 Jesus used a popular expectation about teachers of the Law as symbolic physicians and turned it around to teach how welcome outcasts were to God and how far the self-righteous were from God (Matthew 9:13).

FINAL THOUGHTS

Why does Jesus save outcasts? Because in their despised condition, they are more open to the gospel and more willing to repent than the self-righteous and comfortable.

- If you have never come to Christ because you think you are too far gone, then come
 to Christ as an outcast and discover how welcome you really are.
- As believers, let us never separate ourselves from those who need Jesus most and be like Him instead, in His mercy. After all, that's what Communion reminds us all about.

1. ANG PAGTAWAG KAY MATTHEW (Luke 5:27-28)

- Isang Di-karapat-dapat na Alagad, v. 27a "After this he went out and saw a tax collector named Levi, sitting at the tax booth."
- b. Isang Di-inaasahan na Kautusan, v. 27b "And he said to him, "Follow me."
- Isang Di-mauurungan na Pagsunod, v. 28 "And leaving everything, he rose and followed him."

2. ANG PAGTAWAG SA MGA MAKASALANAN (Luke 5:29-32)

- a. Isang Di-pangkaraniwang Pagdiriwang, v. 29 "And Levi made him a great feast in his house, and there was a large company of tax collectors and others reclining at table with them."
- b. Isang Di-matuwid na Katanungan, v. 30 "And the Pharisees and their scribes grumbled at his disciples, saying, "Why do you eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners?"

Isang Di-inaasahang Kagandahang-loob, v. 31–32 — "And Jesus answered them,

"Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. I had not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance."

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God... (Romans 3:23)

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth. (Romans 1:18)

THE CALL OF JESUS

The Lord Jesus is God's only way for us to be forgiven and reconciled to God. He took the judgment for our sins on the Cross, and whoever comes to Christ for forgiveness, He gives new life and an eternal relationship with God.

66 Jesus said "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:23)

The Lord Jesus is calling out to us: "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." (Matthew 11:28–30)

WHAT MUST WE DO?
