## **Annulment, Divorce, and Remarriage**

MALACHI 2:13-16; MATTHEW 19:3-9; 1 CORINTHIANS 7:12-15

God allowed divorce as a concession for the aggrieved spouse subjected to unrepentant adultery or permanent abandonment (Matthew 5:32; 19:9; 1 Corinthians 7:12–15). It's an accommodation that violates God's original purpose for the permanence of marriage.

Since divorce was never God's original intention, we should avoid divorce (Malachi 2:13–16). Believers should never consider annulment/divorce except in exceptional circumstances; even in those circumstances, it should be regarded with the utmost reluctance.

#### Two Biblical Grounds for Dissolving a Marriage

- UNREPENTANT ADULTERY: Jesus used the word porneia (Matthew 5:32; 19:9), a general term that encompasses sexual sin, such as adultery, homosexuality, bestiality, and incest.
  - Forgiveness and reconciliation are always preferable to divorce, even when adultery has
    occurred (Matthew 18:21–22). After every attempt has been made to bring the sinning
    partner to repentance, the Bible permits release for the faithful partner through divorce
    (Matthew 5:32; 1 Corinthians 7:15).
- PERMANENT ABANDONMENT: An unbelieving spouse leaves the believing partner (1 Corinthians 7:12–15). Divorce is allowed in such situations because "God has called us to peace" (v. 15).
  - When an unbeliever leaves, forcing them to stay may create greater tension and conflict.
     Hence, Paul stated, "If the unbelieving one leaves, let him [or her] leave" (v. 15).

#### Four Principles Concerning Biblical Grounds for Remarriage

- Remarriage is permitted for the aggrieved spouse only when the divorce was on Biblical grounds (Romans 7:1–3; 1 Corinthians 7:39). But serious efforts should be made at reconciliation, including the church's intervention, before they can remarry.
- After serious efforts have been made toward reconciliation, the aggrieved spouse, together
  with the church leaders, may realize the marriage is irreparably broken (Matthew 19:9;
  1 Corinthians 7:15). In such cases, remarriage is allowable for the aggrieved if taken with the
  serious consideration that this cuts off all possibility of a reconciliation that God may yet
  produce.
- If the offending spouse remarries, the former marriage is dissolved, and the aggrieved spouse may be free to remarry another believer (Matthew 19:9).
- 4. The offending partner should repent and be reconciled to God and the spouse (1 Corinthians 7:11; 1 John 1:9). If it's too late because the spouse has remarried, they should remain single, having left their marriage in an unbiblical way (Matthew 19:9; Luke 16:18; 1 Corinthians 7:11).

#### Final Thoughts

Don't lose hope if you feel trapped in a bad marriage. As you grow in the Lord and read His Word, you'll find principles to help you live with satisfaction and joy. Stick through the hard times and work on the tough issues. Though your present suffering is being used for your good, God has not left you without hope. ■

## Paghihiwalay at Pag-aasawa Muli

MALACHI 2:13-16; MATTHEW 19:3-9; 1 CORINTHIANS 7:12-15

Ang paghihiwalay ay pinahintulot ng Diyos upang bigyan lunas ang isang asawang naargabyado ng walang pagsisising pangangalunya or permanenteng paglisan (Matthew 5:32; 19:9; 1 Corinthians 7:12–15). Ito ay isang akomodasyon na labag sa habang-buhay na disenyo ng Diyos para sa pag-aasawa. Dapat iwasan ang paghihiwalay dahil labag ito sa kalooban ng Diyos (Malachi 2:13–16). Hindi ito dapat isipin ng mga mananampalataya maliban lang sa pambihirang sitwasyon at mayroong matinding pag-aatubili.

#### Mga Biblikal Na Dahilan Para Sa Paghihiwalay

- WALANG PAGSISISING PANGANGALUNYA: "Porneia" and salitang ginamit ni Hesus (Matthew 5:32; 19:9). And kahulugan nito ay and lahat nd uri nd kahalayand sekswal.
  - Ang pagpapatawad at pagkakasundo ay laging mas mabuti kaysa sa paghihiwalay, kahit na may pangangalunya (Matthew 18:21–22).
  - Ngunit kung nagawa na ang lahat upang maibalik ang may-sala sa pagsisisi, may pahintulot ang Biblia na pakawalan ang naargabyadong asawa nito sa pamamagitan ng paghihiwalay (Matthew 5:32; 1 Corinthians 7:15).
- PERMANENTENG PAGLISAN: Ito ang paglisan ng isang asawang di-mananampalataya (1 Corinthians 7:12–15). Ang paghihiwalay ay pinapahintulot dito sapagkat "God has called us to peace" (v. 15).
  - Kapag ang di-mananampalataya na asawa ay nais umalis, ang pagpilit sa kanila na manatili ay maaaring magresulta sa mas higit pang pag-aaway. Datapwat, "If the unbelieving one leaves, let him [or her] leave" (v. 15) sabi ni Apostol Pablo.

#### Mga Prinsipyo Para Sa Pag-aasawa Muli

- Ang pag-aasawa muli ay pinapahintulot lamang kung ang dahilan ng pagkakahiwalay ay Biblikal (Romans 7:1–3; 1 Corinthians 7:39).
- Ang lahat ay dapat gawin muna upang magkasundo (kasama na dito ang tulong ng kapatiran), bago magdesisyon na ang kanilang pagiging mag-asawa ay tunay na sira na (Matthew 19:9; 1 Corinthians 7:15). Kapag narating na ang desisyon na ito, dapat isaisip na wala nang pagkakasundo na posible pagkatapos nito.
- Kung ang nagkasalang asawa, na di-mananampalataya, ay mag-asawa muli, ang dati niyang kasal ay wala na, at ang naargabyadong asawa ay malaya nang mag-asawa muli ng kapwa mananampalataya.
- 4. Ang nagkasalang asawa ay dapat magsisi at manumbalik sa Diyos at sa kanyang asawa (1 Corinthians 7:11; 1 John 1:9). Kung huli na ang lahat, at nakapag-asawa na muli ang asawa niya, dapat siyang manatiling walang asawa, sapagkat siya ay nakipaghiwalay sa isang di-Biblikal na paraan (Matthew 19:9; Luke 16:18; 1 Corinthians 7:11).

#### Hamon

Hindi dapat mawalan ng pag-asa kung kayo ay nasa gitna ng isang masamang pag-aasawa. Sa inyong paglago sa inyong kaugnayan sa Diyos at sa Kanyang Salita, makakahanap kayo ng mga prinsipyo na makakatulong sa inyo na mamuhay nang may kagalakan at kasiyahan. Manatili kayo sa gitna ng mahihirap na panahon at pagtagumpayan ang mga pagsubok. Ang inyong mga paghihirap ay gagamitin ng Diyos para sa inyong paglagong espiritwal, at hindi Niya kayo pababayaan na walang pag-asa. ■
