By two questions His detractors could not answer, Jesus clarified and qualified what the Sabbath is for and reminded us Who has the right to do that. In Luke 6:5, Jesus asserted His authority over the Sabbath; in verses 6-10, He demonstrated it.

"Have you not read what David did when he was hungry... he entered the house of God and took and ate the bread of the Presence, which is not lawful for any but the priests to eat, and also gave it to those with him?"

- The starving disciples were not violating the Law by eating the grain (Deuteronomy 23:25). But according to the legalistic interpretation of Jesus' enemies, this constituted work on Sabbath, which was prohibited.
- Jesus showed that God is more concerned about meeting real needs than protecting religious rules.
 David and his men should be saved from starvation than die from a temporary law. God desires mercy, not sacrifice (Matthew 12:7).
- When people put ceremonial rules above real needs, it shows how little they know the heart of God. God gave the Law to help people, not to hurt them. The Sabbath was God's gift to us. By legalistic interpretations, the Pharisees had turned the Sabbath into a burden instead of a blessing. It will take the Lord of the Sabbath to correct this.
- By claiming to be Lord of the Sabbath, Jesus was claiming equality with the Creator of the Sabbath (Genesis 2:1–2).

"I ask you, is it lawful on the Sabbath to do good or to do harm, to save life or to destroy it?"

- This could have been a setup based on verse 7 and the ensuing words of Jesus (to do harm, to destroy). The disabled man may have been planted to trap Jesus. But the only thing Jesus felt for him was compassion.
- With supernatural insight, Jesus asked a question meant to expose their hypocrisy. Jesus demonstrated that the Sabbath is a day for doing good and saving; when we relate with God and men to give and not get, a day for serving and not being served.
- The Sabbath isn't just for our restoration but, as God gives us the opportunity, a day to restore others, too.

FINAL THOUGHTS

The Sabbath was meant for our rest and restoration, proof that God perfects and completes everything He starts (Genesis 2:3), and a reminder that we are not God. Because the Sabbath was meant for our rest, we must be blessed, not stressed, in observing it. "The Sabbath was made for man, and not man for the Sabbath" (Mark 2:27). Let's make sure our restoration is above all, spiritual, on this special day we set aside to worship our Lord of the Sabbath. ■

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Sa pamamagitan ng dalawang tanong na hindi masagot ng Kanyang mga kalaban, nilinaw ni Hesus kung para saan ang Sabbath at kung sino ang Panginoon nito. Sa Luke 6:5, itinaguyod ni Hesus ang Kanyang awtoridad sa Sabbath. Sa verses 6-10, Kanyang ipinakita ito.

"Have you not read what David did when he was hungry... he entered the house of God and took and ate the bread of the Presence, which is not lawful for any but the priests to eat, and also gave it to those with him?"

 Hindi nilalabag ng mga disipulo ang Batas sa kanilang pagkain ng trigo (Deuteronomy 23:25). Ngunit ayon sa legalistic na interpretasyon ng Kanyang mga kalaban, ito ay pagtatrabaho sa araw ng Sabbath na siyang

ipinagbabawal ng Batas.

• Ipinakita ni Hesus na ang Diyos Ama ay mas interesado sa pagtugon ng mga tunay na pangangailangan ng mga tao, higit sa pagprotekta sa mga alituntunin ng relihiyon. Mas importante ang maligtas si David at ang kanyang mga kasama sa gutom, kaysa sa mamatay dahil sa pagsunod lang sa batas na pansamantalang larawan lamang ng kabanalan ng Diyos. Mas ninanais ng Diyos ang kahabagan, kaysa sa mga kaloob (Matthew 12:7).

• Kapag inuuna ng mga tao ang mga reglamentong seremonyal sa tunay na pangangailangan ng mga tao, ipinapamalas nila ang kanilang mababaw na pagunawa ng puso ng Diyos. Ibinigay ng Diyos ang Batas upang tulungan ang tao, hindi saktan sila. Ang Sabbath ay kaloob ng Diyos sa atin. Sa kanilang legalistic na interpretasyon ng Batas, ginawa nila itong pabigat imbis na pagpapala. Tanging ang Panginoon lang ng Sabbath ang makatutuwid nito.

 Sa Kanyang pagsabi na Siya ang Panginoon ng Sabbath, idineklara Niya na Siya ay ang Lumikha nito

(Genesis 2:1-2).

"I ask you, is it lawful on the Sabbath to do good or to do harm, to save life or to destroy it?"

 Malamang ito ay isang sadya na "set-up" ayon sa v. 7, at ang mga ginamit na salita ni Hesus sa v. 9 (to do harm, to destroy). Maaaring "planted" ang lalaking may kapansanan. Ngunit pagmamalasakit lang ang naramdaman ni Hesus para sa kanya.

 Sa pamamagitan ng Kanyang supernatural na kaalaman, nabunyag ni Hesus ang kanilang kapalaluan. Ipinakita ni Hesus na ang Sabbath ay isang pagkakataon na gumawa ng mabuti at maglingkod sa

ating kapwa.

 Ang Sabbath ay hindi lamang para sa ating kapahingahan, kundi isang oportunidad upang paglingkuran ang ating kapwa.

HAMON

Ang Sabbath ay para sa kapahingahan at pagtubos ng lakas, isang pagpapakita na kinukumpleto ng Diyos ang lahat ng Kanyang inumpisahan (Genesis 2:3). Ito ay isang paalala sa atin na hindi tayo Diyos. Sapagkat ang Sabbath ay para tayo magpahinga, dapat natin tanggapin ito na pagpapala, at hindi sanhi ng pag-aalala sa ating pagsunod dito.
