God desires every believer to take hold and enjoy every spiritual blessing in Christ (Ephesians 1:3). Why do some believers not fully enjoy what God promised? We gain some helpful insights from the land distribution to the two tribes of Joseph – Ephraim and Manasseh. Note three reasons Israel couldn't fully possess what God promised, which can also happen to us today:

Disobedience to God's Mandate (Joshua 16:10; 17:12–13)

 Both tribes failed to follow God's mandate fully and would pay the price later. It was more a problem of "wouldn't" than "couldn't."

2. Discontent about God's Gift (Joshua 17:14)

Both tribes approached Joshua with a brazen request.
 Unlike Caleb's request, which was based on faith in God, this request was based on a feeling of entitlement. Then and now, this has damaging consequences to any believer.

3. Doubt about God's Adequacy (Joshua 17:16)

 Despite the sound advice and inspiring challenge of their fellow Ephraimite, Joshua (v. 15), they did not rise to the potential blessings of faith but fell to the level of their fears. Even Joshua's subsequent encouragement was not heeded because it is never mentioned again in Scripture.

Which of these is hindering you? Remember: God is enough. He always fulfills His Word because His only desire is what's best for us. His character doesn't change with every situation, while our faith often does.

In contrast to them, five women show us the way to possessing what God promised:

A Determination to Claim God's Promise (Joshua 17:3-4)

• The beautiful backstory of these five ladies is Numbers 27:1–11. Many years later, with a faith like Caleb and similar trust in God's Word, they claim what is rightfully theirs. In the same way that Caleb reminds us of God's heart for non-Israelites, we now see God's heart for the fairer gender. Are you equally determined to live a life completely given over to the absolute faithfulness of God?

Final Thoughts

Israel eventually went her way instead of God's. Ultimately, the land had to be taken away from them. They had to lose the gift to appreciate it. May God give us the courage to keep believing when life raises new challenges so that we may possess what God has promised.

Kung minsan kailangan mawala ang isang bagay para natin makita ang halaga nito. Ibigay nawa sa atin ng Diyos ang patuloy na pagtitiwala sa Kanya sa harap ng mga hamon ng buhay, upang ating ganap na makamit ang Kanyang mga pangako sa atin.



Nais ng Diyos na makamit ng bawat mananampalataya ang lahat ng mga pagpapalang espirituwal natin kay Kristo Hesus (Ephesians 1:3). Bakit ba hindi matamasa nang lubos ng ibang mga mananampalataya ang ipinangako na ng Diyos? Makikita natin ang ilang sanhi nito sa kwento ng pamamahagi ng lupa ng dalawang tribo ni Joseph – Ephraim at Manasseh. Merong tatlong dahilan kung bakit hindi nila ganap na nakamit ang ipinangako na ng Diyos, na maaari ring mangyari sa atin ngayon...

1. Pagsuway sa Mandato ng Diyos (Joshua 16:10; 17:12–13)

 Hindi ganap na sinunod ng dalawang tribo na ito and mandato ng Diyos, na kanilang pinagsisihan sa huli. Hindi ito dahil sa hindi nila kaya, kundi dahil ayaw nilang gawin.

Pagkawalang-kasiyahan sa Kaloob ng Diyos (Joshua 17:14)

 Lumapit sila kay Joshua na may mapagmataas na kahilingan. Di katulad ng hiling ni Caleb na may pananampalataya, ang kanilang kahilingan ay mula sa pagmamataas. Hindi talaga makabubuti ito sa kahit na sinong mananampalataya.

3. Pagduda sa Kasapatan ng Diyos (Joshua 17:16)

 Hindi nila pinakinggan ang mabuting payo ng ka-tribo nila na si Joshua na isang Ephraimite (v. 15), at hindi tuloy nila natamo ang pagpapala ng pananampalataya, kundi nagpatalo sila sa kanilang mga takot.

Alin sa mga ito ang humahadlang sa inyo? Tandaan natin na ang Diyos ay sapat. Lagi Niyang tinutupad ang Kanyang salita dahil nais Niya ang pinaka-mabuti para sa atin. Ang Kanyang karakter ay hindi nagbabago, di katulad ng ating pananampalataya na madalas ay nanghihina.

Kakaiba naman ang ipinakitang kumpiyansa ng mga ka-tribo nilang mga babae sa pag-angkin ng ipinangako ng Diyos sa kanila.

Ang Mga Determinadong Angkinin ang Pangako ng Diyos (Joshua 17:3-4)

- Ang kanilang kwento ay nasa Numbers 27:1–11. Pagkatapos ng maraming taon, katulad ni Caleb, kanilang inangkin ang kanilang karampatang mana.
- Katulad ng nakita nating kagandahang-loob ng Diyos sa mga hindi purong Israelita, kita natin dito ang puso ng Diyos para sa mga kababaihan.
- Tayo ba ay determinado rin na mabuhay nang ganap sa ilalim ng katapatan ng Diyos?

- Outreaches with Samaritana and the Correctional Institution for Women in collaboration with Mercy Ministry
