God's promises are meant to stimulate, not sedate. He does not want us to take them for granted but to seize them.



When Joshua started distributing land, Caleb came to claim the promises of God and then conquered the giants. Judah came but was less successful (Joshua 15:63). The tribes of Joseph came, questioned God, and were even less successful. The remaining seven tribes didn't even show interest. This was the last straw for Joshua. He took the seven tribes to task and reminded us of the peril of procrastination:

THE PROMISED REST OF GOD IS ROOTED IN OUR WORSHIP (Joshua 18:1)

- Shiloh means "place of rest." Moses said that "when He gives you rest," God would choose where He was to be worshipped (Deuteronomy 12:10-14).
- In worship, we enjoy the rest God won for us, rejoice in God who did it all for us, and learn faithfulness to Him, who gave it all to us.

THE PROMISED POSSESSIONS OF GOD REQUIRE OUR WORK (Joshua 18:2–10)

- a. The Peril of Procrastination (vv. 2-3).
 - What made the seven tribes stand on the premises instead of the promises of God? Maybe the prospect of giving up the ease of nomadic life, wandering around without rootedness, and perhaps war-weariness from seven years of battle. Find yourself in the same situation?
 - What were the consequences? Others were affected (Joshua 22:4). Worst of all, they were defying the will of God after everything He did for them. Delaying in doing God's will is never "a small sin."

b. The Proposal of Joshua (vv. 4-8).

 God did not need this survey. They did. They had to see how much grace they had already received in the miraculously conquered lands they now owned. Appreciating grace is a powerful way of shaking us out of laxity and laziness.


c. The Providence of God (vv. 9–10).

Casting lots was an interim way for God's leaders to know God's will. Today, we are blessed to have the will of God revealed in the sixty-six books of the Bible. We have direct access to the Throne of Grace through prayer (Hebrews 4:16). What keeps us from doing the work?

FINAL THOUGHTS

God's promises are meant to stimulate, not sedate. He does not want us to take them for granted but to seize them. His purpose is evident in 2 Peter 1:3-4 "His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness... by which He has granted to us His precious and very great promises, so that through them you may become partakers of the divine nature."

Ang pagtitiwala sa Diyos ay nagsisimula kay Kristo Hesus. Aminin natin na hindi natin kakayanin ang buhay kung aasa lamang tayo sa sarili nating lakas. Lumapit tayo sa Diyos nang may pagkukumbaba upang tayo ay Kanyang magabayan sa araw-araw.

1. Ang Panimula: Pagsamba nang sama-sama sa Panginoon (Joshua 18:1)

 Ang kahulugan ng Shiloh ay "place of rest". Binibigyan tayo ng kapahingahan ng Diyos upang tayo'y makasamba nang buong puso at may pasasalamat. (Deuteronomy 12:10–14)

Ang Suliranin: Pagpapaliban sa Utos ng Diyos (Joshua 18:2–3)

May kasabihan na delayed obedience is still disobedience.
 Marami tayong maiiwasang problema kung hindi tayo magiging pabaya at kung susunod tayo nang may buong pagtitiwala sa Diyos. (Psalm 119:57–60; Joshua 1:8–9)

3. Ang Solusyon: Pagiging Responsable na may Buong Pananalig sa Diyos (Joshua 18:4–8)

 "Nasa Diyos ang awa. Nasa tao ang gawa." Paalala ito na hindi pwede ang basta-basta sa Diyos. Binigyan Niya tayo ng kakayahan na pangalagaan ang mga biyayang inilaan ng Diyos para sa atin. (Genesis 1:27-28; 1 Corinthians 12:4-6)

4. Ang Kahihinatnan: Kasiguraduhan sa Pangako Diyos (Joshua 18:9–10)

 Salamat sa Diyos at hindi napapako ang Kanyang mga pangako. Makakasiguro tayo na matatakbuhan natin ang Diyos sa anumang oras o sitwasyon sa pamamagitan ng panalangin at pag-aaral ng Kanyang Salita. (John 14:6; Hebrews 4:16)

APPLICATION

- Purihin at sambahin natin ang Diyos nang may pasasalamat dahil sa Kanyang kabutihan at katapatan.
- Huwag mag-atubili sa pagsunod sa Diyos. Gawin natin ang dapat nating gawin. Tapat ang Diyos sa Kanyang pangako, ngunit hindi ito magic na basta na lang lilitaw sa mga buhay natin
