The Levites were the poorest tribe because they had no land to inherit. But from the highest standpoint – God's – they were richest of all because God Himself was their inheritance (Joshua 13:33).



The Levites and their cities have more to say to us than we realize. As those who continue their ministry in the New Testament era, we have much to learn from them and how the people of God responded to them. What do we see in the passage about their calling and how God enabled them to fulfill it?

TRUE FAITH IN GOD EMBOLDENS US TO ASK ACCORDING TO HIS PROMISE (Joshua 21:1–2).

- The bold request of the Levites reminds us of Caleb and the daughters of Zelophehad. They were not driven by an attitude of entitlement but by their faith in God's promises.
- Prayer never means presuming on God. It simply means that we can take God at His Word when we ask according to His will (1 John 5:14). When we delight ourselves in the Lord, He will put the right desires in our hearts (Psalm 37:4).

THE SACRIFICE OF GOD'S SERVANTS IS ENABLED BY THE SACRIFICE OF GOD'S PEOPLE (Joshua 21:3–8).

- It's beautiful to see the gracious response of the Israelites. It
 was a great sacrifice for them to give up land to make room
 for the houses of the Levites and choice pasturelands for
 their livestock.
- Paul reminds believers that "those who proclaim the gospel should get their living by the gospel" (1 Corinthians 9:14).
 Without the sacrifice of God's people, His full-time servants would never be able to continue. God save us from the "theology of poverty"!


AS NEW TESTAMENT CHRISTIANS, WE ARE A KINGDOM OF PRIESTS FOR CHRIST (Joshua 21:9–42; 1 Peter 2:5, 9; Revelation 1:6; Revelation 5:9–10).

- The Levites had different functions, but one goal to glorify God by helping and leading others to worship God. And God wanted the Levites scattered all over because He had special things for them to do for all Israelites.
- God wants us to be Levites in our local community. God wants Christians scattered, not huddled. What do we bring to our local communities?
 - i. You know God personally.
 - You bring knowledge about God to your neighborhood. A critical function of the Levites was to be teachers of the law (Deuteronomy 33:10).
 - iii. You know how to contact God on behalf of others.

FINAL THOUGHTS

The Levites were the poorest tribe because they had no land to inherit. But from the highest standpoint − God's − they were richest of all because God Himself was their inheritance (Joshua 13:33). They represent what Paul said of himself in Philippians 3:8: "I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For His sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ." How rich are you in the sight of God? ■

Ang mga Levite ay walang minanang kayamanang lupain, ngunit sa mata ng ating Diyos minana nila ang kayamanang makalangit dahil ang Diyos ang kanilang mana (Joshua 13:33).



Ang salaysay ng pagbibigay ng mga lungsod sa mga Levite ay mayroong mga aral para sa ating mga mananampalataya sa ilalim ng Bagong Tipan. Kakaiba at espesyal ang kanilang papel at tungkulin sa buhay ng Israel, at magandang tingnan kung paano sila itinaguyod ng Diyos at ng kanilang mga kababayan.

ANG TUNAY NA NANANAMPALATAYA SA DIYOS, INAASAHAN ANG KANYANG MGA PANGAKO (Joshua 21:1–2).

- Ang paghiling ng mga Levite ay katulad ng ginawa ni Caleb at ng mga anak ni Zelophehad – puno ng kanilang pagtitiwala sa pangako ng Diyos at walang pagmamalaki.
- Sa ating pananalangin, hindi natin pinangungunahan ang Diyos. Pinanghahawakan lang natin ang Kanyang salita sa ating paghiling ng ayon sa Kanyang kalooban (1 John 5:14). Kapag ginawa nating kaaliwan ang Kanyang kagustuhan, ilalagay Niya ang mga tamang pagnanasa sa ating mga puso (Psalm 37:4).

ANG PAGSASAKRIPISYO NG MGA LINGKOD NG DIYOS AY PINALALAKAS NG PAGSASAKRIPISYO NG BAYAN NG DIYOS (Joshua 21:3–8).

- Nakakatuwa makita ang pagsasakripisyo ng ibang mga Israelite ng bahagi ng kanilang minanang lupain at piling pastulan para maging tirahan at kabuhayan ng mga Levite.
- "Those who proclaim the gospel should get their living by the gospel" (1 Corinthians 9:14). Kung hindi magsasakripisyo ang kaanib ng Iglesya ng Diyos, ang Kanyang mga lingkod ay hindi makapagpapatuloy.

ANG MGA KRISTIYANO SA ILALIM NG BAGONG TIPAN AY ISANG KAHARIAN NG MGA PARI PARA KAY KRISTO (Joshua 21:9–42; 1 Peter 2:5, 9; Revelation 1:6; Revelation 5:9–10).

- Ang mga Levite ay maraming katungkulan ngunit iisa ang layunin – ang kaluwalhatian ng Diyos sa pamumuno ng pananambahan ng Diyos. At sila ay ikinalat sa buong Israel upang matupad nila ang kanilang iba't ibang mga tungkulin.
- Kalooban ng Diyos na tayong mga Kristiyano ngayon ay maging mga Levite sa ating mga pamayanang lokal. Nais Niya na tayo ay kumalat at hindi magbuklod-buklod.
 - o Upang kilalanin ang Diyos nang personal
 - Upang ipakilala ang Diyos sa ating komunidad tulad ng mga Levite na mga tagapagturo ng Batas (Deuteronomy 33:10)
 - o Upang maging tulay sa Diyos para sa ating mga kapwa
