This passage blesses our Communion today because, in 1 Corinthians 11:27-32, we learn that it is good to face our sins honestly, judge them, and confess them.

This portion of Jesus' "Sermon on the Plain" explains His command in Luke 6:36: "Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful." God's mercy is often associated with His withholding condemnation and giving forgiveness instead (Psalm 130:3-4). Consequently, the command to be merciful leads to not judging or condemning others and being forgiving and gracious instead.

These words of Jesus answer two expected questions we all have regarding being merciful.

1. (vv. 37–38) How do we show mercy to others, like God has shown mercy to us?

- a. (vv. 37–38a) To show mercy to others means not to judge them but to forgive and be generous to them.
- b. (v. 38b) To show mercy to others, we must never forget that how we treat others will affect how God treats us (Matthew 6:14–15).
 James 2:13 says: "For judgment is without mercy to one who has shown no mercy. Mercy triumphs over judgment." As God will judge us with mercy, we should judge others with mercy.

2. (vv. 39-42) Why is it so hard to show mercy to others, even though God has been merciful to us?

We struggle to show mercy because, in our innermost hearts, we are reluctant to judge our sins.

- **a.** (vv. 39–40) We are like the blind, leading the blind when we don't judge our sins.
- b. (vv. 41–42) We can help others with their sins after first judging our own.

Final Thoughts

This passage blesses our Communion today because, in 1 Corinthians 11:27–32, we learn that it is good to face our sins honestly, judge them, and confess them. Verse 28 commands, "Let a man examine himself." God will have to judge us if we do not judge our sins. But "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9). Have a blessed Communion today! ■

Noong nakaraan natutunan natin ang ilang katotohanan tungkol sa mga tunay na alagad ni Kristo.

- Ang mga tunay na alagad ni Kristo Hesus ay may tunay na pag-ibig na binuhos na sa kanilang mga puso ng Espiritu Santo (Luke 6:27-28; Romans 5:5).
- Ang umiibig sa hindi kaibig-ibig ang tanda na sila ay tunay na mga anak ng Diyos (Luke 6:35).
- Ang pag-ibig na ganito ay magreresulta sa kahabagan sa kapwa na katulad ng kahabagan ng Diyos (Luke 6:36).

Sa ating buhay Kristiyano kailangan natin kung minsan ang humusga ng iba upang malapatan ng mapagmahal na disiplina (Matthew 18:15–17), o di kaya'y maiwasan ang mga huwad o bulaang propeta (Luke 6:43–45; Matthew 7:6, 15, 16). Dito natin kailangan na magtagumpay ang mapagmahal na kahabagan sa mapagkundina na paghuhusga (James 2:13).

1. ANG ALAGAD NG DIYOS AY MAY MAPAGPATAWAD NA DIWA SA PAGHUHUSGA SA KAPWA (Luke 6:37–38)

- Huwag maging mapanghusga na may mapagkundina na diwa (Luke 6:37a; Matthew 7:1–2; Romans 14:10-12; James 4:11, 12)
- Maging labis na mapagpatawad at mapagbigay sa kapwa (Luke 6:37b; Matthew 6:14-15; Mark 11:25; Ephesians 4:32; Colossians 3:13)

2. ANG ALAGAD NG DIYOS AY TAPAT AT PATAS SA PAGHUHUSGA SA SARILI AT SA IBA (Luke 6:39-42)

- Ang bulag sa sariling kasalanan hindi makakagabay sa kapwa makasalanan (Luke 6:39–40; Matthew 15:14; 23:16; 10:24–25)
- Ang hindi kumikilala sa sariling pagkukulang, walang karapatan humusga sa pagkukulang ng iba (Luke 6:41–42; Matthew 7:3-5; Romans 2:1–3)

Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory! (Isaiah 6:3)

THE CRISIS WE FACE

We all have failed God's standard and face God's righteous judgment.

66 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God... (Romans 3:23)

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth. (Romans 1:18)

THE CALL OF JESUS

The Lord Jesus is God's only way for us to be forgiven and reconciled to God. He took the judgment for our sins on the Cross, and whoever comes to Christ for forgiveness, He gives new life and an eternal relationship with God.

66 Jesus said "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:23)

The Lord Jesus is calling out to us: "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." (Matthew 11:28–30)
