LESSON AIM

- GG members will be vigilant to protect themselves from the world's influence.

INTRODUCTION

In this fast-paced world, new technologies are constantly being thought of and invented. At the rate at which new technologies are being developed, Christians find themselves playing catch-up, trying to figure out where these fit into the principles and guidelines of God's Word.

The contrast between the blessed and the wicked (vv. 1-6)

The first chapter in the book of Psalms shows the contrast between the blessed and the wicked. This is a good basis for Christians to reflect upon how they live their lives. This includes how they make use of available technologies.

- How did the psalmist describe the actions of the blessed man? What are the things he avoids (and why)? On the other hand, what are the things he immerses himself in? (cf. Joshua 1:8; Psalm 119:103)
- 2. What analogies did the psalmist use to describe the blessed man? How do you interpret the analogy of him being like a tree planted in water (cf. Psalm 42:1-2; John 7:37-39), being fruitful (cf. John 15:5), and being prosperous (cf. Joshua 1:8)?
- 3. In contrast, what does the psalmist say about the wicked? What analogy did the psalmist use to describe them, and how do you interpret the analogy?
- 4. According to the psalmist, what is the ultimate outcome of the life of the wicked?
- 5. How can you relate these to the use of technology? Explain why you see technology either as inherently good, neutral, or evil.
