Should Christians Care About Creation Care?

Genesis 1:20–28; 2:15

Is creation care something God has commanded us to do? Can we care for nature without worshipping it or neglecting the spiritual needs of people?

WHAT IS CREATION CARE?

Creation care is Biblical stewardship of the environment. It is not environmental activism or alarmism.

WHY SHOULD WE CARE ABOUT CREATION?

The Bible proves we have a mandate to care for creation:

Principle no. 1: God owns everything in nature. He created it for His own delight and purposes, and we must respect that (Genesis 1:1, Psalm 24:1).

Principle no. 2: God is personally involved in creation care. We who bow to Him can do no less (Job chapters 38–39).

Principle no. 3: Though corrupted by humanity's fall, God will free creation from its bondage. God's redemptive plan includes all creation! (Romans 8:19–22, Isaiah 11:6–9)

Principle no. 4: Humankind was given dominion over nature to work it and care for it, not destroy it (Genesis 1:26–28, Genesis 2:15).

Principle no. 5: God gives practical guidelines about the care of nature, which remind us to make our own (Leviticus 25:3–5, Deuteronomy 20:19–20, Proverbs 12:10).

HOW DO WE CARE FOR CREATION?

Small things can add up to big change and be a positive witness when done collectively and consistently (examples will be given for each):

1. Live Sustainably.
2. Volunteer and Clean Up.
3. Reduce Waste.
4. Conserve Energy.
5. Save Water.
6. Plant Trees and Gardens.
7. Speak up for Creation Care.

Final Thoughts

Creation care isn't just an environmental issue – it's part of our witness. By being good stewards of God's creation, we make our communities and the environment better and embody the love and responsibility which the Bible commands. ■

Ano Ba Ang Sinasabi Ng Biblia Tungkol sa “Creation Care”?

Genesis 1:26–28; 2:15

Iniutos ba ng Diyos sa atin ang pangangalaga ng ating kalikasan? Maaari ba nating alagaan ang kalikasan nang hindi sinasamba ito o pinapabayaan ang espirituwal na pangangailangan ng ating kapwa?

ANO BA ANG “CREATION CARE”?

Ang “creation care” ay “Biblical stewardship;” ang pangangalaga ng kalikasan bilang mga katiwala ng Panginoon. Iba ito sa “environmental activism” o “alarmism.”

ANO BA ANG SINASABI NG BIBLIA TUNGKOL SA PANGANGALAGA NG KALIKASAN?

1. Pag-aari ng Diyos ang lahat ng kalikasan. Nilikha Niya ito para sa Kanyang kasiyahan at mga layunin; isang katotohanan na dapat nating igalang (Genesis 1:1; Psalm 24:1).
2. Pinangangalagaan ng Diyos ang Kanyang nilikha, at ito ay dapat nating tularan bilang mga anak Niya (Job 38:39).
3. Palalayain ng Diyos ang sang-nilikha sa pagka-alipin nito sa kamandag ng kasalanan, dahil kasama sa pagtubos ng Panginoon ang lahat ng Kanyang nilikha (Genesis 3:17–18; Romans 8:19–22, Isaiah 11:6–9).
4. Pamamahala ng daigdig ay ibinigay sa tao upang pangalagaan ito, hindi abusuhin at sirain (Genesis 1:26–28; 2:15).
5. Praktikal ang mga alituntunin na ibinigay ng Diyos sa Kanyang salita para sa pangangalaga ng kalikasan (Leviticus 25:3–5; Deuteronomy 20:19–20; Proverbs 12:10).

ANO ANG MAAARI NATING GAWIN PARA PANGALAGAAN ANG KALIKASAN?

Mga maliliit na bagay ay maaaring maging permanenteng pagbabago, at mabuting testimonyo kung gagawin nating lahat:

1. Mamuhay nang may pagpapanatili ng kalikasan.
2. Mag-boluntaryo sa paglilinis ng ating paligid.
3. Magbawas ng basura.
4. Magtipid sa kuryente.
5. Magtipid ng tubig.
6. Magtanim ng mga puno at hardin.
7. Makilahok sa mga usapin tungkol sa pangangalaga ng kalikasan.

Ang pangangalaga ng kalikasan ay hindi lamang “environmental issue” – bahagi ito ng ating testimonyo bilang mga Kristiyano. Sa pamamagitan ng pagiging mabuting katiwala ng nilikha ng Diyos, mapapabuti natin ang ating mga komunidad at kapaligiran sa isang mapagmahal at responsableng paraan, na siyang inuutos sa atin ng Biblia. ■

"The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and covered up. Then in his joy he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field." – Matthew 13:44 (ESV)

By His grace and for God's glory, may we live by and exhibit the joy of being citizens of God's Kingdom so that people around us would also experience the joy of belonging to Christ as sons and daughters of God (John 1:12; Romans 8:14-17; Galatians 4:4-7). We hope to do this in practical ways through the **PRISM** *Oikos* approach:

- **Pray:** Pray for a long-time colleague, classmate or family member who you know has urgent life struggles and concerns. Pray for the opportune time to personally reach out to him or her.
- **Relate:** Message your colleague, classmate, or family member and ask them genuinely how they are doing. Respond to one of their social media posts to seek how you may be able to listen, and how you may naturally respond to them in a friendly and compassionate manner.
- **Invite:** Go together to our Ortigas Community Worship (Wednesday evenings 6:30 PM onwards) or at our various worship services, church programs, or at your Growth Group meeting.
- **Share:** Open up about your life and share how Christ is helping you grow through your own struggles. Share your most-recent Bible reflection. Be equipped on Eventail and Evangelism Explosion Training, and use our Gospel Tracts to share about the Gospel.
- **Mentor:** Be trained to disciple by joining the How to Grow class so that you are equipped to intentionally disciple and walk alongside your colleague, friend, or family member who wants to know more about Jesus.
